Freedom without a proper balance of form

Most of you reading this have lived in a free society for a long time. Some of us have come to take freedom for granted, though I suspect that would be less true of us than it would be for the general population.

I know of no one who has written about freedom and the attacks upon it so astutely as Dr. Francis A. Schaeffer. I share it here because of Schaeffer's significant warning. Schaeffer clearly saw even back in 1984 what was unfolding. He wrote and spoke of what was coming if we could not stave off the assault upon our beloved America.

Quoting from Schaeffer's *The Great Evangelical Disaster*:

The problem is this: If there is not a proper balance between form and freedom, then the society will move in either of two extremes. Freedom, without a proper balance of form, will lead to chaos and to the total breakdown of society. Form, without a proper balance of freedom, will lead to authoritarianism, and to the destruction of individual and social freedom. But note further: no society can exist in a state of chaos. And whenever chaos has reigned for even a short time, it has given birth to the imposition of arbitrary control.

In our country we have enjoyed enormous human freedom. But at the same time this freedom has been founded upon forms of government, law, culture, and social morality which have given stability to individual and social life, and have kept our freedoms from leading to chaos. There is a balance here between form and freedom which we have come to take as natural in the world. But it is not natural.

And we are utterly foolish if we do not recognize that this unique balance which

we have inherited from the Reformation thought-forms is not automatic in a fallen world. This is clear when we look at the long span of history. But it is equally clear when we read the daily newspaper and see half the world locked in totalitarian oppression. ...

But it is clear that through the Reformation many were brought to Christ and that the absolutes of the Bible became widely disseminated in the culture as a whole. The freedoms which grew out of this were tremendous; and yet, with the forms grounded in a biblical consensus of ethos, the freedoms did not lead to chaos.

But something has happened in the last 60 years (editor's note: now 89 years) The freedom that was once founded on a Biblical consensus and a Christian ethos has now become autonomous freedom cut loose from all constraints. Here we have the world spirit of our age -- autonomous Man setting himself up as God, in defiance of the knowledge and the moral and spiritual truth which God has given. Here is the reason why we have a moral breakdown in every area of life. The titanic freedoms which we once enjoyed have been cut loose from their Christian restraints and are becoming a force of destruction leading to chaos. And when this happens, there really are very few alternatives. All morality becomes relative, law becomes arbitrary, and society moves toward disintegration. In personal life and social life, compassion is swallowed up by self-interest. ... when the memory of the Christian consensus which gave us freedom within the Biblical form is increasingly forgotten, a manipulating authoritarianism will tend to fill the vacuum. At this point the words "right" and "left" will make little difference. They are the only two roads to the same end; the results are the same. An elite, an authoritarianism as such, will gradually force form on society so that it will not go into chaos -- and most people would accept it."

Sadly, Schaeffer's words ring true! I was 38 years old when Schaeffer wrote this book - his last book as he died that same year in 1984. I read, studied, and taught his book as a Wednesday night class back in that day. I was gripped by it because though things were seemingly tranquil at the time Schaeffer's writings made sense even then.

Presently, almost daily there are high profile individuals - one by one - undermining the Christian ethos - individuals expressing they have determined they are in support of same-sex marriage. [Robert Portman, Hillary Clinton, Laura Bush, former Vice-President Dick Cheney, celebrities, pastors, politicians - all legitimizing the LGBT (lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender) agenda.]

You are probably familiar with former President John Adams oft-quoted warning: We have no government armed with power capable of contending with human passions unbridled by morality and religion. Avarice, ambition, revenge or gallantry would break the strongest cords of our Constitution as a whale goes through a net. Our Constitution is designed only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate for any other.

The Christian consensus is gone, and, let's be honest with ourselves - we have seen it coming for a long time.

We have been a blessed people far beyond perhaps anyone who has ever lived on this earth, even as many have lived under persecution, deprivation, starvation.

Let us run the race that is set before us with perseverance, recognizing that God has prepared us and is preparing us for such a time as this.

Also, while loved ones and even family members succumb to the cultural pressures and call us old-fashioned or a homophobe, let us uphold God's Word and stand unashamedly for Biblical marriage and in opposition to what God calls an abomination.

May God help us not to despair, and if perchance we are in despair, by faith let us move quickly out of despair.

For indeed, this is not a time for whining, but rather the time - as never before - to demonstrate that the words that we have testified, of our love for God, are far more than cliches and jingles but rather are statements of faith supported by boldness even in the midst of hardship and suffering. That God would be glorified!

A time for whimpering and whining?

Much could be said about some of my early years of faith when God drew me to Himself by His Spirit and Word.

I would weep as I heard hymns of the faith - many that I had never heard before. I never doubted God's call or His presence in my life.

The last eleven years of my eighteen years as a teacher I believed that God had a specific calling upon my life.

Now as a 66 year old who has walked by faith for 43 years and experienced God's faithful hand and abiding presence since the very beginning - I am in awe of the reality and working power of God! He has taken me out of darkness and stood me up. Stood me up to live and to stand some more.

Many of us have seen difficult times. We have overcome before; we can do so again.

The Vietnam War era (and prior) was an extremely dark period in American history: the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, the assassination of his brother and then U.S. Attorney General, Robert Kennedy, and the assassination of Martin Luther King; the escalating anti-war protests, the National Guard shootings at Kent State University where the lives of college protestors were taken; the massive loss of life of U.S. military and Vietnamese, Cambodian, Thai, etc.; Watergate; the resignation of President Richard M. Nixon. The hurried and harried withdrawal of the American military from Saigon and Vietnam in the '70s; the President Jimmy Carter administration; high inflation; low military morale; a declining America.

Negativity, unrest and division marked America with little to no hope for a

restoration of American exceptionalism: the special character of the United States as a uniquely free nation based on democratic ideals and personal liberty.

We need to seek His light and walk in the abiding Word of God. Great benefit is garnered through leaders in the field.

One such voice is Mark Levin, former Chief of Staff for former U.S. Attorney General Ed Meese during the Reagan years.

Levin writes: The Conservative must become more engaged in public matters. It is his nature to live and let live, to attend to his family, to volunteer time with his church and synagogue, and to quietly assist a friend, a neighbor, or even a stranger. These are certainly admirable qualities that contribute to the overall health of the community. But it is no longer enough. The Statist's counterrevolution has turned the instrumentalities of public affairs and public governance against the civil society. They can no longer be left to the devices of the Statist, which is largely the case today.

Parents and grandparents must take it upon themselves to teach their children and grandchildren to believe in and appreciate the principles of the American civil society and stress the import of preserving and improving the society. They will need to teach their offspring that the Statist threatens their generation's liberty and prosperity, and to resist ideology alluring trends and fads. Parents and grandparents by the millions can counteract the State's indoctrination of their children and grandchildren in government schools and by other Statist institutions simply by conferring their knowledge, beliefs, and ideals on them over the dinner table, in the car, or at bedtime. If undertaken on an intimate, purposeful, and consistent basis, it will shape a generation of new conservatives. [Taken from "Liberty and Tyranny", 2009 - a conservative manifesto]

Lifetime TV's "Preachers' Daughters" - Christianity as a carnival side show

Not a good sign when a show entitled "Preachers' Daughters" begins with the disclaimer – "This program may contain subject matter and language disturbing to some viewers. Viewer discretion is advised."

"Preachers' Daughters," a new reality series on the cable channel Lifetime, follows three real-life pastors and their families - showcasing the pastors' rebellious, wayward teen daughters. Lifetime's website describes the show "Preachers' Daughters" as "following the lives of three families for a behind-the-altar look at what happens at home after the sermon concludes ..."

The daughter of one Pentecostal pastor is rebelling against the strict, protective boundaries and restrictions her parents have put in place. She defies her parents, sneaks out of the house, lies to her father and mother, and states that her biggest aspiration is to be a porn star. "I kind of want to be a porn star because of all the attention and it feels like you're free. You're really free! And I want to be free. I'm tired of this little safe, sheltered life." Based on her antics behind her parent's backs with a boy she describes as "everything my dad doesn't want for me" –she, sadly, could be on her way to fulfilling that goal.

The next preacher's daughter, whose father is the pastor of an undenominational church, spent the previous summer partying hard – drinking, doing drugs, and sleeping with several guys. She became pregnant at 17 and is now living with her parents who help her raise her baby. She admits she almost had an abortion and confesses she doesn't

know which guy is the father of her baby.

Family number three focuses on a 16-year-old daughter who is just starting to date. Both of her divorced parents are preachers. Her mother also gives explicit abstinence messages to teen groups – much to the horror of her daughter. However, the daughter seems to get her sex education from other sources as she is shown plying her older sister for information about how to engage in oral sex.

All of the parents depicted in "Preachers' Daughters" seem very genuine in their desire to protect and guide their daughters – although some parenting techniques leave much to be desired. Viewers see brokenhearted fathers praying for their wayward daughters.

We are all sinners – thus the need for a Savior. Every parent knows the grief of watching children stumble and fall – and Christians aren't immune from such sorrow. However, those realities of life are not Lifetime's purpose in airing the show "Preachers' Daughters." It is obvious the show is intended to portray Christians as hypocrites whose faith makes no difference in the raising of their children. In fact, it is made to appear that the "rules" of Christianity only cause the daughters to rebel all the more.

Lifetime drives this point home with the display of scripture at the beginning of each segment of the episode to showcase that - while God's Word says this – "we'll show you how these hypocritical Christians really act."

Near the beginning of the show, scripture from I Thessalonians 4:3-7 is shown on the screen with the quote: "God has not called us to an unclean life, but one of purity." Viewers then see the above mentioned behavior of the preachers' daughters. Later in the show Lifetime posts this scriptural reference: "For this is the will of God: Your sanctification, that you abstain from sexual immorality." (I Thes. 4:3) Which is followed up by scenes of the 16-year-old

discussing sex acts.

Lifetime turns Christianity into a carnival side show – a "Christian" version of reality TV's "Honey Boo Boo" - sensationalizing the human failures and sinful nature that all people face – yes, even Christians. Yet the world loves to gleefully poke fingers at Christians when we stumble and fall. Then they can say "look, we're better than those phony Christians" – totally missing the meaning of grace.

Believers in Christ are sinners saved by grace – not perfect, just forgiven. However, Lifetime's "Preachers' Daughters" doesn't point unbelieving viewers to that grace that saves us from our sins.

We Christians aren't the Pharisees - Lifetime TV is. We're the woman who deserved stoning, but received mercy instead.

Victoria's Secret: selling sex to sixth-graders

Move over women's lingerie – Victoria's Secret is adding a new line of merchandise. In recent years Victoria's Secret added their "Pink" line of lingerie - supposedly marketed to college-age girls. **Now Victoria's Secret has announced it will be marketing to an even younger group - middle school girls (also referred to as "tweens").**

Interspersed with women's push-up bras, thongs, and erotic lingerie, Victoria's Secret will be selling sexy lingerie to sixth-graders.

As BusinessWeek reported: "Forget Training Bras. Girls Are Buying Lingerie."

Chief Financial Officer Stuart Burgdoerfer of Limited Brands, of which Victoria's Secret is a subsidiary, announced the company's new marketing demographic at a recent conference, claiming about younger girls: ***"They want to be older, and they want to be cool like the girl in college, and that's part of the magic of what we do at Pink."***

This push to draw in "tween" girls was evident at last December's Victoria's Secret so-called "Fashion Show" which featured performances by teenage heartthrob Justin Bieber. As the baby-faced Bieber performed in the midst of models clad in brightly-colored lingerie – the color scheme of most 13-year-old girls' bedrooms – the message was clear who their target audience was.

Victoria's Secret "Pink" line is using the marketing slogan "Bright Young Things" to advertise lingerie for teens, including

panties emblazoned with words such as "Call Me," "Wild," and "Feeling Lucky."

It certainly is telling when even NBC won't show an image of Victoria's Secret teen lingerie. On the March 9 "Today Show," NBC aired a segment regarding this new marketing scheme by Victoria's Secret, in which the NBC reporter stated: ***"The latest campaign features underwear too racy to show here."***

The segment went on to interview passersby about Victoria's Secret marketing of lingerie to young teens. One man on the street said: *"They are not for young, little girls."* A mom stated: *"I don't think it has to be sexy at 13 or 14 years old."*

In our highly sexualized culture, little girls (and boys) increasingly are no longer viewed as children whose innocence we as a society have a responsibility to protect. Instead, they are a commodity to be sexualized and exploited.

Retailers salivate over a new - and vulnerable - consumer group to milk and to manipulate.

Retail Analyst Hitha Prabhakar claims these young teens "represent about 335 billion dollars worth of spending power."

According to Timothy Matz, a former advertising director who now teaches marketing and advertising: ***"It's beginner-level lingerie. It's gateway marketing. It's like a gateway drug, the same concept --to get you using that brand earlier."***

Sadly, it is no surprise when we hear of very young teens (and even preteens) involved in sexual activity – not when the entertainment and retail industries bombard them with such sexualized messages. Children at younger and younger ages becoming concerned about body image; little girls dressing provocatively; young boys involved in pornography.

Children are victimized by a culture that sees their worth only in dollars - robbing them of their innocence. To put it bluntly

– a culture teaching little girls to act like sluts and teaching little boys to treat them as such.

Psychiatrist Dr. Gail Saltz cautioned: ***"I think we are already facing how to keep younger and younger girls from getting involved in sexual activity that they're not ready for, that puts them at risk for all kinds of things – physically and emotionally."***

In 1980 there was great outrage when 15-year-old Brooke Shields posed provocatively in a blue jean ad for Calvin Klein – an ad that would be tame by today's standards. The suggestive ad slogan was: "Nothing comes between me and my Calvins." The television version of this Calvin Klein advertisement was banned by networks and the ad received nearly universal condemnation by a culture that still knew when a line had been crossed.

America in 1980 recognized the difference between fashion and pornography and still cared about the exploitation of children. Not so much in 2013 America.

Sex sells – even to children. But at what cost?

Perhaps corporate America might want to remember Christ's warning in Matthew 18:6. I've heard millstones are awfully heavy.

Our researchers monitor dozens of broadcasts, emails and websites, and use their expertise on right-wing movements to analyze and distill that information for the general public.

“We hope that by shedding light on the activities of right-wing organizations, we can expose the risks that their extreme and intolerant agendas present to our country. ...”
