Strong emotions settle over me. Grandpa. Loved. Helper. Friend. Comforter.

For me, a temporary respite from the task before me.

My heart heavy - filled with the realities that my grandchildren live in a world with advancing discord, upheaval, oppression, godlessness and needless death and dying.

Back to the point, "Why do the nations rage?"

Books have been and are being written on this subject down through the ages. In a word, nations rage because man is sinful and in total rebellion to the Creator of the universe who they do not in the least acknowledge.

But in Psalm 2 verse 4 the Psalmist writes: "He who sits in the heavens laughs; the Lord holds them in derision."

The prophets in the Old Testament were often "negative," but that seems far more often than not to be what truth mandates.

I wanted to mention this since I do not think anyone at ADA guilty of excessive negativity, at least in my hearing. And I don't think you can tone down much of what you say without watering down a needed message. There are enough ministries dangerously watering down messages; I do not think we need to, or should, go down that path.

... I wish we could be more positive, but that will require revival, a change in the moral climate of our country, and redirection of the hearts of our citizens.

You and ADA are most definitely NOT too negative, given the current scene. I believe that the Lord would agree, and is pleased with your efforts, and the manner in which they're carried out.

Pray for us. We need it and appreciate it. To God be the glory.

Clean It and Start Over

I've been to Washington D.C a few times, including a three month span living in the area where my idea of a good time on the weekends was to hang out with Thomas Jefferson and Abraham Lincoln's statues in the National Mall.

But two visits stick out in my mind particularly.

The first was for the Independence Day celebration in 1997. I have distinct memories of my eight year old self and my family sitting on the steps of the Capitol Building with a million dollar view of a tree in the Capitol lawn which was allegedly masking the fireworks we were there to see.

Several days before our evening of Independence Tree watching, however, I had a somewhat better view of a much rarer event – a parade marking the internment of the last Civil War veteran to be buried in Gettysburg National Cemetery. I remember the view from my dad's shoulders of a horse drawn carriage carrying several ancient women – the last surviving widows of Civil War veterans.

In a way, that funeral was the end of a dark chapter in the story of freedom in America – the last known veteran of a war fought, at least in part, over the legality of owning people was laid in his final resting place.

My other particularly powerful memory of D.C. comes from November of 2009, four months before the passage of the Affordable Care Act, A.K.A. Obamacare.

The tens of thousands of those present were again seeing the close of another chapter in the story of America's freedom. A lot has happened since 2009, and, if you're like me, some of the particulars of those debates have faded from memory.

But that's why we have YouTube, and there, in the collective video memory of our society, I found this brilliant articulation of exactly what those protests were all about, "This is not about healthcare, this is really about ideology. This is about whether or not they can make the biggest leap forward in establishing this cradle to grave welfare state which they believe rightfully should replace the American idea – the exceptionalism of this country."

Do you remember that kind of language? Or the senators and congressmen running around labeling Obama's healthcare plan, "socialism?"

How about this one: "This thing, however, is not a policy issue, it's more of an ideological crusade; and so the architecture of this legislation is to have the federal government basically take over the health care sector and that is where I just can't go. It's just completely wrong, and that is why you can't perfect or improve upon this legislation, you've got to clean it and start over."

Those were the passionate arguments of a brilliant young member of the Ways and Means Committee, now Speaker Paul Ryan.

It was this kind of talk against Obamacare and President Obama's other social programs which roused the conservative base in Obama's first term.

If the Tea Party was a baby, Obamacare was the doctor that smacked it's behind to make it cry. I don't think it's overstating it to say that without Obamacare there would be no TEA Party; without the TEA Party there would be no revival of conservative values; without those conservative values there would be no 2016 election with the Republican's taking all three branches of government.

The Republicans in power owe their jobs to their promise to repeal "socialized medicine."

Yet it is exactly that ideological foundation which 2010 Paul Ryan decries, which 2017 Paul Ryan builds his bill on. In fact, he said in multiple interviews at that time, "You

can't perfect or improve this bill, you have to start over," yet "improving this bill" is exactly what they've tried to do.

From the very beginning of the health care debate in 2008, political voices told us how difficult repealing Obamacare would be – that you'd need both houses and the presidency to ever get that done, and Republicans would probably never have that.

Now they do. Yet, when Republicans got the chance to fulfill the promise they've been running on for the last eight years, they tried to simply tweak the law which they called "completely wrong."

As many of the men and woman siding with the Speaker reminded us over and over again during those debates, our congressmen and our senators work for us.

Let us insist that our representatives do not stop fighting until they have what they promised they could deliver in 2010, as Paul Ryan described at the time.

"The shame of this... is we could get the uninsured insured, we could have healthcare for people with preexisting conditions... without a government takeover of healthcare. We've offered legislation to do that."

Let's hold out for that legislation again.

An Epidemic of Evil

Six hundred children a year are rescued from sex trafficking in the United States. Six hundred vulnerable children who were assaulted, abused, and scarred for life, but these 600 are the "fortunate" ones – they were eventually rescued. The FBI estimates that there are tens of thousands of children sold for sex each year in the U.S. alone.

In an interview with the BBC, Joseph Campbell of the FBI's Criminal Investigative Division stated: "The level of pedophilia is just unprecedented right now. We have so many cases constantly of individuals in all walks of life, from the very wealthy ... to all other levels engaged in child pornography, child exploitation ... it just seems to be almost at an epidemic level."

That epidemic reaches into our own government. Last year Daniel Payne, the director of the Pentagon's Defense Security Service, stated that the "amount of child porn" on government computers and devices "is just unbelievable."

As just one example, in 2015, the U.S. State Department's Director of Counter-terrorism, Daniel Rosen, was arrested for computer solicitation of a child under 15 years old for sex.

When even a Homeland Security inspector, Georg Hristovski, was arrested for soliciting a mother to "sell" her young daughter, it's no wonder that Special Agent John Reynolds, also with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, said "the incidence of child sexual exploitation has reached staggering proportions."

In one sting operation in Southern California last year, 238 child sex predators were arrested – among them were

community leaders, entertainers, white collar professionals, a Buddhist monk, and a man who traveled from Australia to buy a six-year-old boy.

So-called "sex tourism" where men travel to other countries to preyon children and women is rampant. Major sporting events such as the Olympics, World Cup, and the Super Bowl are also huge draws for traffickers.

Slavery did not end in the 19th century. Human trafficking of children and women is so widespread both in the United States and around the world, that it is estimated that there are more people enslaved today than 200 years ago when slavery was legal.

This is not just a third world issue. Not only is this taking place in the United States, but the U.S. is a major exporter of child exploitation. Lifesite News reports: "According to Europol, the Europe-wide police investigative agency, half of all servers distributing child sex abuse are located in the U.S." Lifesite went on to report that in 2014 there were 2,048 websites in the U.S. trading in images of child sexual assault. In 2015, Europol reported that U.S. child sex abuse websites increased to 2,617—far greater than any other country. It's estimated that 80,000 children had been trafficked to produce these images.

My home state of Michigan has one of the highest rates of sex trafficking. Last year the Ingham County Prosecutor who had served as the county's chief law enforcement officer for 19 years was charged with multiple sex crimes. As the Detroit Free Press reported: thousands of women and girls are quietly, sometimes violently, manipulated and abused into selling their bodies for sex every year... "I assure you, it's not a victimless crime," said Dr. LaClaire Bouknight, a Lansing physician and chairwoman of the Capital Area Anti-Trafficking Alliance. "Many of the pimps are very violent. They're controlling the women with drugs, threats, threats to harm their families,... It's not a happy life. It's not a Julia Roberts story."

While the national media turns a blind eye

to this epidemic, follow local news coverage and its common to see reports of minors, young children, even infants being sexually assaulted. Just a few headlines from recent days prove that point.

- "Chicago teen repeatedly sexually assaulted on Facebook Live" 3.21.17
- "Oklahoma State Senator Charged with Engaging in Child Prostitution" 3.15.17
- "Tennessee Teacher Accused of Abducting Missing 15-year-old Girl" 3.21.17

"Baby Laylah was 'probably' sexually abused - Court records reveal disturbing allegations about what happened to a Newaygo 14-month-old before she died." 2.22.17

Each one is a life destroyed. This is not an easy subject to write about or read about. It's horrific. Yet it cannot be ignored. Not only is it an epidemic, it's also symptomatic of a culture that has abandoned Biblical truth. Each of these headlines could be ripped from the pages of the closing chapters of the book of Judges where "everyone did what was right in his own eyes."


"The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?" (Jeremiah 17:9) For all of our sophistication, the evil that typified Sodom and Gomorrah still prevails today.

While we most definitely need increased law enforcement and media attention to combat the plague of sex trafficking, such horrors will only end when Christ reigns in the human heart. We need action and we need prayer that God will bring about repentance in our nation.

Who's the Real Beast?

"So if it's a Disney movie, it's got to be good. Right?—WRONG!" By now most have heard about Disney's newest remake—Beauty and the Beast—and its "exclusively gay moment." This not only has caused controversy between Disney and the Church, but has sparked controversy and hostility within the church as well.

Don Wildmon, founder of American Family Association (AFA), and Bill Johnson, founder of American Decency Association (ADA), have long warned about the dangers of Disney and its ongoing attacks against the family, holiness, and decency. They've passionately warned that the love affair between the Christian and the Magical Kingdom is an illicit and dangerous one.

Believers are called to distinguish between the holy and the profane; why do so many lack discernment, especially where entertainment is concerned? There is such a lack of concern with what we fill our minds with; even more disturbing, there is often a greater lack of caution when it comes to what we allow our children's minds to be filled with. Everything that goes into one's mind-whether it enters the eye-gate, the ear-gate, or dwells in one's mind-plays a role in what that person becomes. We must take a stand and set boundaries for ourselves and our children. Post a sentry at the gates! Encourage your children to be like Daniel, who purposed in his heart to not defile himself, even with food and drink.

Disney's most recent melee against Christ, decency, and Biblical—normal—marriage comes in the form of this movie remake. This attack can be well summed up with a few quotes:

"GLAAD has finally gotten their way, and Disney is giving the LGBTQ community what it has been wanting for a while now. A truly gay Disney character." (MOVIEWEB)

Director Bill Condon: "LeFou is somebody who on one day wants to be Gaston and on another day wants to kiss Gaston. He's confused about what he wants. It's somebody who's just realising that he has these feelings. And Josh makes something really subtle and delicious out of it. And that's what has its payoff at the end, which I don't want to give away. But it is a nice, exclusively gay moment in a Disney movie."

Attitude (a British gay lifestyle magazine) editor-in-chief: "By representing same-sex attraction in this short but explicitly gay scene, the studio is sending out a message that this is normal and natural – and this is a message that will be heard in every country of the world, even countries where it's still socially unacceptable or even illegal to be gay." Mr. Cain goes on to applaud Disney, stating that he hopes this will help "to change attitudes and bring about real social progress."

That Disney would "gamble" \$300 million on a "nice, exclusively gay moment" is very telling. It shows that this movie mogul believes that pandering to homosexuality in our culture and to our children is a safe "bet." Why not? They've been doing their part to promote and push the LGBT agenda as being normal. They must not fear any fiscal danger from a church that has been complicit in supporting their agendas.

Consider another danger of Disney taking these "classics" and remaking them with even less subtle LGBT overtones. The children who saw these movies in the '90s have an emotional investment in them. They've enjoyed these fond moments of laughter and good times which are now in their memories. These grown-up children will now take their own children to see these remade movies that portray the LGBT lifestyle as normal. This also is done in an enjoyable manner. Now there are two generations that have fond memories and have been-at least a little-indoctrinated with the normalcy of what God calls abominable.

Disney is not a friend to families, Christ, or America. It produces and promotes witchcraft, LGBT agendas, poor morals, and the list goes on. Recently one of their animated shows on the Disney XD channel showed a theater full of children kissing in same-sex pairs. When it comes to entertainment we must be so careful; it changes our thinking patterns and eventually what we stand for or against. Our children are being changed clip by clip, image by image. Take a righteous stand!

In an article last year, we warned about Disney's subtle attacks: "The magical kingdom attacks absolute truth by entertaining us with stories that transform our minds little by little. Would Jesus approve of this?" (Then give Biblical rationale that falls within the whole counsel of God). Finally, ask, "Does this company support things which run contrary to God's standards?"

The true believer is to know the difference between the sacred and the profane. Ours is to teach that difference.

Take a stand against abominable entertainments; have conversations about them with your children, family, and friends. We must not remain silent in the face of such entertainments that undermine and destroy our culture and our sensitivity to God. (This goes way beyond Beauty and the Beast) America is being destroyed from within, one entertainment choice at a time. Lack of Biblical response to those things which destroy, will leave us broken and weak as families and as a nation.

"Islam is Islam and That's It!"

It is true that the statements of both men serve to sever the logical, in fact, blatant connections between Islam and what I will call Hot Jihad (terrorism, war) and Cold Jihad (the imposition of Islamic law and customs through migration into Western democracies, also Hot Jihad). Both are components of the age-old design of Islamic conquest. With regard to Sebastian Gorka, a friend and strong supporter of [my book] American Betrayal back in the day, it grieves me to have to say so, but I have to say so.

It is also true that this catastrophically wrong assessment of Islam is by no means unique to these two men. I wish it were. I know of no one in the US government or military who has a realistic view of Islam — that is, a view derived from the study of authoritative Islamic texts and centuries of jihad and dhimmitude. None. Donald Trump the candidate actually came the closest, but, as president, he appears to be enveloped by the "establishment," which actually thinks Al Qaeda ... or the Taliban or ISIS or the next regrouping thousands of miles and oceans and deserts away is the main threat to these United States not the government's outsourcing of our understanding of Islam to jihad-affiliates; not the incursion of sharia -affiliates; not the incursion of sharia into US finance; not the tranches of Islamic money subverting US education; not the seeding of mosques, generously funded by Islamic governments, throughout America to establish the sharia (Islamic law) for still-burgeoning Muslim immigrant and refugee populations. All three terms, even as they seem to originate on three different points of the political spectrum, depend on the exact same fantasy: that there exists some non-radical, non-extreme, non-violent "Islam," a peaceable and anodyne faith with texts and laws and a godhead that are separate and unrelated to jihad violence and conquest, Islamic supremacism and dhimmitude, and, more dangerous still, that are compatible, and, indeed, basically interchangeable with the Christianity and Judaism of Western society.

This. Is. Not. True.

Violent extremism" divorces jihad violence from Islam entirely, which is non-sense.

"Tiny band of extremists" divorces jihad violence from an imaginary Islam that is non-extreme.

"Radical Islamic terrorism" does exactly the same thing: If terrorism is the product of "radical" Islam then there must be some plain-Jane and non-radical-Islam that is perfectly ok.

But it doesn't exist! Islam is radical. Islam is extreme. So be it.

As Turkey's Erdogan so memorably put it, "Islam is Islam and that's it."
