Several weeks ago out in the parking lot on a Sunday evening after church, Jeremiah (age 23) discussed with me that he has wanted to work with us here at American Decency Association. ...

We are not a ministry that sends multiple mailings month after month seeking support. We don't take our asking for extra help lightly!

On the basis of the response to this mailing in early December, we believed that God was leading us to continue seeking support to bring this need to completion.

Minutes after emailing the December 30 email, I received a call from a friend of this ministry sharing in our enthusiasm for adding Jeremiah to our staff.

has been leading us to. As of this writing (January 19, 2011), we are now at \$79,614.00 We are seeking \$100,000 by January 31, 2011. Although giving has slowed down significantly in recent days, we continue to wait upon the Lord for His continued help.

By adding Jeremiah after adding Chris in September of 2009, we would have two committed Christian young men whose gifts complement each other significantly!

Jeremiah would bring technological and artistic skills, as well as speaking skills. He is well grounded in the Bible. We have discussed getting into churches and speaking to youth and others regarding the need to "pursue holiness without which no man shall see the Lord." [Hebrews 12:14]

My hope is that Chris and Jeremiah can team together in going out and warning, exhorting, encouraging young people to "guard their hearts."

I believe that God is doing something special here and to ignore it or put it off would be to ignore His guiding hand. Is He doing something special? Here are what a few others are saying:

Quoting The Timothy Plan:

Apple pie, Chevrolet and Campbell Soup? Most of us can remember warming up with soup and crackers made by almost everyone's mother on a cold winters' day. More often than not, the soup was produced by Campbell's, that icon of American ingenuity and capitalism.

Established in 1869 by Joseph A. Campbell, the products from this company have literally touched almost every human life in America and 120 other countries. The company has carefully cultivated an image of wholesomeness, family and virtue for more than 140 years. In fact they are so cautious about their image that the standard soup label has changed very little since the beginning.

However, a pretty label on a can and a carefully cultivated image can sometimes mask an immoral social agenda. Unfortunately, when we run into these situations, as much as it pains us, we feel compelled to expose hypocrisy so that you can make life decisions that are consistent with your traditional moral values.

... Campbell Soup makes more than just soups. They also seem to want to help redefine family and sexual morality. If this was only in isolated instances, it could be understood as sometimes these things happen in extremely large companies. The pattern of Campbell Soup supporting and even promoting a homosexual agenda, however, appears to be wide-spread, deliberate and ongoing.

In fact, the support by Campbell Soup for the homosexual agenda is so complete that the Human Rights Campaign* has given them an index score of 100% for support and positive re-reinforcement of that lifestyle. This includes direct support in the form of materials, meeting places and paid advertising promoting the advancement of the [homosexual] agenda.

Campbell's may not be your old familiar family friendly soup making company any longer. They seem to have a social agenda that may surprise you.



The Case for Christianity: a live Lee Stroebel simulcast! ADA Headquarters, March 12 - 10:30 am - 4:30 pm

The world today is not a nice place for Christians.

Christians in the Middle East are targeted for bombings and other violence. Brothers and sisters in East Asia also are under persecution. According to Voice of the Martyrs, "More Christians are in prison or under detention in China than in any other country."

In the West, we don't have to worry about physical persecution, at least not yet, but day by day the attacks seem to be stronger. It is a popular belief among "intellectuals" that you can't be a Christian and be intelligent, or at least you can't believe the Bible and be intelligent which amounts to the same thing. In almost any arena where Christianity pops its head into public life, that head is quickly lopped off - i.e. manger scenes, Merry Christmases, the Ten Commandments, graduation prayers, street preachers, Franklin Graham's speaking at the Pentagon, etc.

Under all this pressure, it is refreshing to be reminded that there is an intellectual, fact-based argument for Christianity. That argument is laid out with expertise and conviction by former investigativejournalist Lee Strobel.

Strobel is an atheist-turned-apologist and the turning point in his life took place at the end of his own detailed search for the historical facts concerning the truth of the Bible.

He has written several books which recount his interviews with various scholars concerning their individual areas of expertise. To give you an example, here is a snippet from the book "The Case for Christ" of an interview with Dr. Craig Blomburg Professor of the New Testament at Denver Seminary on the validity of the gospels.

"'When the gospels mention people, places, and events, do they check out to be correct in cases in which they can be independently verified?' Often such corroboration is invaluable in assessing whether a writer has a commitment to accuracy.

'Yes, they do, and the longer people explore this, the more the details get confirmed,' Blomberg replied, 'Within the last hundred years archaeology has repeatedly unearthed discoveries that have confirmed specific references in the gospels, particularly the gospel of John - ironically, the one that's supposedly so suspect!

'Now, yes, there are still some unresolved issues, and there have been times when archaeology has created new problems, but those are a tiny minority compared with the number of examples of corroboration.

'In addition, we can learn through non-Christian sources a lot of facts about Jesus that corroborate key teachings and events in his life. And when you stop to think that ancient historians for the most part dealt only with political rulers, emperors, kings, military battles, official religious people, and major philosophical movements, it's remarkable how much we can learn about Jesus and his followers even though they fit none of those categories at the time these historians were writing."

Strobel puts together many such interviews to compose a very valid argument for the intellectual legitimacy of Christianity.

There have been times – perhaps many times – that I have served as a watchman on the tower giving warning regarding upcoming television or radio programs and advertisements - urging friends, family, and others to "guard their heart."

I'm in no way alone in this calling. For that I am so very thankful as the need is great for all of us to be discerning, to warn, to exhort, to encourage others to keep themselves from images, themes and programs that Satan can use to take us down paths that will desensitize, degrade, and destroy!

One person that I know who does this faithfully and very well is Steve Ensley. Steve heads an internet filter ministry known as www.afo.net.

Sometimes he is stuck in a very tough spot in his Internet filtering work where he is forced by good conscience to block websites that, though they may be very popular, feature indecency or pornography.

Recently, Foxnews.com has been causing him great concern. I'll let him speak for himself on this. This statement of Steve's was written to his customers. He is telling them that recently he has been forced to block Foxnews.com. Unless you are a subscriber to Steve's www.afo.net you probably aren't being blocked – you aren't being protected from indecency found even on Foxnews.com as it increasingly tests the consciences of those who have a desire to "keep themselves unspotted from the world."

Quoting Steve:

... You may have noticed lately that the popular news site Foxnews.com has been blocked on several different occasions. Our filtering not only blocks sites based on a list, but it also looks at content, creates a score and then blocks the page if the score exceeds a certain threshold. For some unknown reason, foxnews.com has moved

more and more towards being a tabloid site featuring all kinds of sleazy articles and pictures. Apparently this is to add more sizzle. The result is that the filter detects this content and blocks the page just like it would any other site.

This is extremely frustrating for you and for us! It blocks a site that you may often use for news and you won't know why! For us, we get the frustrated calls and emails wondering why the site is blocked. This is particularly annoying because foxnews. com is one of the few news sites that has a conservative leaning. Or at least that was true in the past. I'm thinking of launching a protest campaign with Fox, so please watch for announcements on actions we can all take to voice our concerns.

Interview with Jeremiah Andersen



Bill Johnson interviewed Jeremiah in recent days with the hopes that you will get to know Jeremiah better. We believe that Jeremiah will be an excellent fit for our ministry as we seek to have a renewed and greater outreach into the lives of young people!

Q: A couple of months ago you and I were visiting in the church parking lot and you said if it ever worked out, you would like to work with us at ADA and with your friend from childhood, Chris. What has brought you to this point?

A. I think that God has been preparing me for His service throughout my whole life. Right now I see a need for people who care about the values of our country to stand up. I continue to see a need for our youth as well as this culture which continues to draw them into a neutral mindset about very controversial issues. God is clear on these issues and we need to do everything we can to let our youth know.

Q: Jeremiah, tell us a little about your educational and church background from youth to this present time.

A. I was raised in a Christian home, brought up in church and also went to a Christian school K-12. Upon completion of high school I studied information technology and took some psychology electives for a year at a Christian college. God has given me the opportunity to have several first hand experiences in working with, youth groups, Christian camps, contractors, photographers, and many other people.

Q: God has given you quite a wealth of work experience and life experience in your young life. Highlight a few of those experiences. A. I have had so many opportunities at my young age. God has taught me such a broad spectrum of things it is very difficult to sum up. I have always been taught to work hard at whatever you do and to do it for God's honor and glory. I think the most important impact in my experiences is volunteering at a Christian camp, and working as a photographer in a portrait studio. Both positions allowed to me to work firsthand with children young and older and through this I have developed a true burden for children, teens, and young adults.

Q: Please share your testimony with us.

A I was saved at an early age of four years old. Shortly after, I was baptized by my pastor at my church. As I grew in the Lord, the Holy Spirit led me to dedicate my life to the Lord's work. I am thankful each day for the privilege to be a child of God and pray that I will never take Him for granted.

Q: What things really excite you about the possibilities of working with ADA?

A. I would have to say I am excited the most to take a stand for God. I know it will not be easy, but I know that God will help me on a daily basis. I am also excited to be a part of such a powerful team at ADA. I think that as I join that team I will become a great asset to ADA as well.

Q: What do you think are a few ways in which you may be able to strengthen American Decency Association?

A. It is my prayer that as I join ADA we can develop a target on youth and help them understand, become educated, and have a zeal to start to stand for what is right in God's eyes.

Q: Does it concern you that with ADA being a faith-based ministry that the bottom could fall out and you could find yourself searching for a job somewhere along the way?

A. I think that being a part of a faith-based ministry is something that could be hard from a human standpoint, but I know that God promises to supply all my needs. So really it is up to me to have the faith that He will do so for me, and I know He will.

Financial Report

At this writing, we have \$80,000 of the \$100,000 we are prayerfully seeking as we desire to add Jeremiah to our staff full-time. \$80,000 have been raised in nearly 45 days enhanced immensely by the gracious gift of \$50,000 at the beginning of the month.

We set the figure of \$100,000 and the time table of January 31 to give indication that we have an enthusiastic base of support to hire Jeremiah and not have to let him go a year later because the funds aren't there.

In the meantime, Jeremiah is receiving valuable training as a machinist and will begin working nights in March. Jeremiah is happy about this as it will allow him to work some hours for us during the day.

Nearly 170 of you have given toward the Jeremiah project. We were hoping for 400 people to give gifts averaging \$250. God is in control and we are following Him.

We hope to have Jeremiah begin to work with us at least by March! We appreciate your prayers and generous support!

That said, there are several ways in which you can stand with us financially at ADA going forward into 2011.
