I'll cite one name to help me cut to the quick - the rest I will leave unnamed. Marcia gets up early in the morning. Prays extensively for people. Despite health issues, thinking of others. She continually finds ways to serve others - looks for people in need and serves from morning to night.

Down through the years, we have had a number of volunteers - a few of them now into their nineties not only volunteering at our office mailings but also in other ministries. Serving, caring, writing letters, active in church, faithful in church attendance, praying - behind the scenes doing what they can to encourage loved ones, families, and young believers.

They look to Jesus as they arise. Spending time with Him reading His word, seeking His face - they ask for His help and His guiding hand! Serving.

I think of a few new friends that I have met who are deeply troubled over the war for the free world - the beheadings, the rapings of innocent ones who dare to oppose Muhammad. These folks are busy from the rising of the sun to the end of the day - researching, writing, speaking, educating, warning, and going before political groups to rally them to understand and take right positions for national security and for guarding America.

I think of a young mother trained as a veterinarian who gave up her practice to adopt international children and, in recent days fighting an amazing fight with international and national bureaucracies through prayer to bring her new daughter home to America. She repeatedly asked for prayer and against all odds her prayers were answered!

But, then there are the apathetic, the lethargic. Much could be said here but I am limited by time and space. Keep this date open! On Friday, March 13, 2015 at 7:00 pm, the American Decency Association will be hosting an event aimed at informing you about human trafficking.

The United States of America has long been known as “the Land of the Free,” so why is it one of the highest ranked countries in the world for human trafficking? Many would associate such disgusting behaviors with Southeast Asia and places other than our beloved America, but it is here that 50,000 women and children are trafficked INTO the United States each year. It’s here that minor-aged victims are sold an average of 10-15 times a day, 6 days a week. America is home to between 100,000 and 300,000 underage girls being sold for sex. This should break your heart; it should make you want to do something.

It’s horrifying. Child pornography has become a \$3 billion dollar industry; one out of every five pornographic images are of a child. I love this country, but I hate the fact that 55% of internet child pornography comes from the United States. The above statistics, and many others beside, came from www.trafficking.org.

This shouldn’t be happening; all life is valuable. Men are supposed to be protectors, not selfish users and abusers. Parents, teach your children that they are created in the image of God; they aren’t meant to be abused nor are they meant to abuse others. Share with them the love God has for them.

Trading Orange Jumpsuits for Robes of White

Usama Bin Laden's body in, we swear to Allah we will mix it with your blood."

However, while the blood of these Christian brothers washed into the sea, they did not need to "wish" for safety – they were already safe in the arms of Jesus Christ. They trusted in their Savior whose Own blood had been shed and now covered them. They had traded orange jumpsuits for robes of white.

"When he opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne. They cried out with a loud voice, "O Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long before you will judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" Then they were each given a white robe and told to rest a little longer, until the number of their fellow servants and their brothers should be complete, who were to be killed as they themselves had been." (Revelation 6:9-11)

Yet what about we American Christians? For the most part, we haven't needed to wish for safety. We *are* relatively safe and secure and removed from having to choose between our faith and our life. No one is threatening to cut off our heads for following Christ. We hear such accounts and are momentarily horrified - then we go back to our comfortable lives.

As R.C. Sproul, Jr. reminds us:

"We in the West, and particularly in these United States ... have lost sight of the reality of what the Christian faith is all about. It is a good thing, do not misunderstand me, it is a blessed thing when a given culture has become so influenced by the Christian faith that men are protected from these kinds of assaults, that we have the opportunity to practice freedom of religion. But it is not a normal thing.

"We live in a world that Jesus described as one in which we should expect persecution from those outside the church. Jesus, in fact, tells us time and again that the very persecution that He experiences is not something unusual, is not something odd,

but it is instead something which we should all have every expectation of receiving. Now again, as privileged Americans, our experience of persecution has been, until more recently, as mild and not particularly challenging as perhaps having to commit social faux pas when we make certain affirmations about the Lordship of Christ in certain social circles. People sometimes look at us like we are a little bit weird, like we are a little bit funny. But we are not experiencing, in this country, what other believers are experiencing in other countries. And we make the mistake of thinking that our circumstance is normal. ...

"When Jesus says to take up your cross, how dishonoring it is to Him that we turn this into a metaphor for the petty little hardships we go through for His Name's sake. Jesus didn't say "I want you to be willing to be socially snubbed because of me. I want you to be willing to be thought of as odd because of me." When Jesus says, "pick up your cross and follow me," do you know what He is saying? He is saying you need to be ready, you need to be prepared to be crucified. Now I am not arguing, again, that it is just or right or proper – of course. Or that it is anything less than vile or wicked when Christians are put to death by the opponents of Jesus Christ. All I am saying is not only is it not surprising, but in the end, it is a deep and a profound honor.

"We think that the way to do great things for the Kingdom is to be great and powerful people. But the power of the Kingdom of Jesus Christ is found in our laying down our lives. In being willing to be scorned, in being willing to be scoffed at, in being willing to be crucified with Him. Friends, we need to look at these news items in light of our calling as Christians. Are we willing, are we ready, are we able to lay down our lives because of our commitment to the Lordship of Jesus Christ? I want to see the Kingdom of Jesus Christ advance, but the Kingdom of Jesus Christ advances by the power of self-sacrifice."

By now most of us have heard the news report of 21 Egyptian Christians recently beheaded by ISIS in Libya. The picture of these 21 men dressed in orange jumpsuits forced to kneel on the beach of the Mediterranean Sea has been all over the news and is now emblazoned on my mind. This is just one of countless atrocities being perpetuated against our Christian brothers and sisters.

Just weeks before this attack President Obama took the opportunity at the National Prayer Breakfast to chastise Christians for deeds done nearly one thousand years ago. Comparing Christian crusaders of yesteryear to Islamic terrorists of today, he stated: *"And lest we get on our high horse and think this is unique to some other place, remember that during the Crusades and the Inquisition, people committed terrible deeds in the name of Christ."*

After all, as our president has previously stated before the United Nations: *"The future must not belong to those who would slander the prophet of Islam."*

Yet while the President has no problem in defending and sympathizing with Islam, the official White House statement following this latest barbaric attack upon Christians only referred to the victims as Egyptian "citizens" – completely ignoring the fact that these men were targeted because of their faith in Christ.

However, the Islamic terrorists made it clear why these men were killed. The video recorded by ISIS of this massacre was entitled: *"A Message Signed With Blood to the Nation of the Cross"* and included a message, stating in part: *"Safety for you crusaders is something you can only wish for ... The sea you have hidden Sheikh*

SI Swimsuit - A Gateway Drug

As research and common sense indicate, those who view (or read) pornography are soon not satisfied with the material they consume and so escalate to more explicit and extreme forms of pornography.

Not only do we know this, but so do the publishers of the Sports Illustrated Swimsuit magazine. This so-called Swimsuit magazine has been and still is a “gateway drug” to harder and harder forms of pornography – especially for young boys. And so, to keep this money-making issue flying off the magazine racks, Sports Illustrated knows it must ratchet up the shock value every year. As they have done this year with a cover that is their most graphic yet.

And we’re not the only ones expressing concern. This cover photo is so explicit, that even liberal news organizations are calling out SI Swimsuit and using terms such as “pornographic” to describe the magazine cover. Business Insider wrote it’s the “most scandalous cover yet” and reported that in a *Us Weekly* poll, “68% of readers thought the cover image resembled porn”.

Many have taken to Twitter and Facebook to express outrage regarding the SI cover. Here are a few comments:

- *Sports Illustrated cover outrageous.. inappropriate..pornographic... unnecessary...nasty. Is there any wonder women are seen as sex objects?*

- *The new sports illustrated cover is classless and inappropriate. Like seriously, cover your vagina, kids see this mag in the grocery store.*

- *Ok, um, is it just me or is this a bit too much? This is Sports Illustrated not Playboy. ...*

And a writer for the Philadelphia Daily News – one who creates an annual “Sexy Singles” spread for that newspaper – writes this:

That’s a little too low, Sports Illustrated.

As the creator of the Daily News’ popular, annual Sexy Singles spread, I understand the need for the magazine to up the ante in terms of hotness each year, but the magazine finally crossed the proverbial line by all but baring a model’s nether regions.

... I hate to be on the side of conservatives but some people doing the tongue clucking have a point. The National Center on Sexual Exploitation sent out a press release accusing Davis’ pose of normalizing ‘genital display, not just with the pages, but also on the front of the magazine. This will be ground level display in most supermarkets, gas stations, bookstores, and airport kiosks for any 10-year-old child to see.’ ...

We at American Decency have been one of the very few voices over the years warning of this concerning magazine, urging stores not to carry it and corporations not to advertise in it.

But it’s not just the cover that’s concerning. Page after page reveals young women in erotic poses – often topless and/or bottomless. For a “swimsuit” magazine, there is very little cloth actually worn by any of the models.

And the advertisers also get in on the act. In some cases there is no difference between the erotic advertisements and the Sports Illustrated photo displays. Such is the case with DirecTV’s 10 pages of ads portraying degrading images of nearly nude women in sexual poses.

Then there is a six page pull-out ad for Dodge Ram. This ad replicates the iconic painting of George Washington, Crossing the Delaware. You can probably visualize this famous painting of then General Washington standing majestically near the bow of a boat with a small crew of soldiers

crossing the river during the Revolutionary War. Only the Dodge ad replaces the Father of our Country with a woman in a bikini standing in the same pose as Washington. In fact, each man featured in this epic painting is replaced with bikini-clad women in this contemptuous Dodge Ram SI Swimsuit ad.

We have noted in recent years, however, that there are fewer and fewer mainline corporations advertising in Sports Illustrated swimsuit. We believe that, as you have stood with us, we have had an impact as we’ve held the advertisers accountable each year.

Sports Illustrated Swimsuit is most likely on display in a store near you – even in “family” shopping centers. You may think it’s impossible to affect change when the magazine is so widespread. However, one person can make a difference!

For example, we know of one woman who monitors her local Wal-Mart not only for the Sports Illustrated Swimsuit magazine, but also the SI swimsuit calendar. She kindly but firmly speaks to the store manager when she has found such concerning material on display. After learning this year’s SI Swimsuit magazine was being sold in her local Wal-Mart, she again spoke to the manager who remembered her concern from previous conversations. He said he didn’t realize the magazine had been stocked by the vendor and removed it right away!

One person spoke out and now countless children, young people, men and women will not be exposed to this pornographic display in this family marketplace!

You, too, can make an impact in your corner. Speak out against the SI Swimsuit magazine in stores where you find it. Take it to the store manager and express your concern about such material in the place you and your family shop.

When we step out in weakness but in faith, God often does his best work in us and through us. Take a stand for righteousness today.

I found the SI Swimsuit edition in the checkouts at one of our local Wal-marts. I spoke with store management who told me they couldn't take them off the shelves for the sake of just one person complaining and that I would have to go through their corporate headquarters. I'm a corporate owner myself and know when a manager is blowing smoke. They can probably do whatever they want if it's in the interest of the corporation. Maybe they didn't want to lose money, but bad PR isn't good for a store either.

It just so happens that the cover is in clear violation of our city ordinance of which I showed her a copy. She still wouldn't budge so I gave her something to think about. 

Fifty Shades - No Grey Area

In last month's newsletter we warned of the incredibly pornographic movie, *Fifty Shades of Grey*, which opened in theaters Valentine's weekend. It's been nearly impossible to avoid the buzz surrounding it as mainstream media has pulled out all the stops to legitimize and promote this degrading movie. Indicative of the state of our culture (and the church), millions flocked to the theater, making this disturbing film a blockbuster.

Frankly, we weren't surprised by the film's popularity. However, that doesn't deter us from being salt and light – in fact it is all the more reason to speak truth. And so, when we found out that our local movie theater had plans to bring *Fifty Shades of Grey* into our community, we spoke out in various ways. Desiring that the church would join us in speaking out about this concern, we contacted nearly all of the pastors/churches in our greater area providing information and a petition to encourage their activism. We also distributed petitions to be circulated, sent out emails encouraging local citizens to express their concern to the theater owner, and wrote a letter to the editor of our local newspaper.

This is what our petition stated:

The movie, to be released on February 13, is based upon a trilogy of books that has been consistently characterized as pornographic, romanticizing sexual abuse and centering on themes of BDSM (Bondage, Discipline/Dominance, Submission/Sadism and Masochism). Promotional movie trailers add credence to our concern. This type of material cultivates a culture of rape and sexual violence which is now permeating our society.

Noted author and youth speaker Pam Stenzel, who has spoken to several area

public schools in recent years, stated: "Fifty Shades is pornographic, nothing less, and the damage that pornography can do to young men is life changing."

Dr. Miriam Grossman, a medical doctor and author of "Unprotected" and "You're Teaching My Child What?" stated: "Excluding hard pornography, I believe Hollywood has never produced a film so hazardous to young women."

This is not about censorship. It is about doing what caring parents, grandparents, and communities have done for many years – standing up for what is worthy and decent and opposing that which is degrading and potentially destructive.

One local television station, WOOD-TV, became aware of our efforts and asked to interview me regarding ADA's efforts and concern. A reporter and film crew came to our office for a 45 minute interview. The reporter also spoke with the theater owner.

We go into interviews knowing that, generally speaking, the reporter conducts themselves winsomely. They are merely doing their job: to get from you as much as they can for the storyline they want to report. Being interviewed, you are in a place of trying to get your important message across.

I was able to articulate my talking points - although most of them were not aired in the brief airtime. As is often the case with secular news media, the real heart and soul of our concern was not conveyed in the report that was aired.

In spite of our efforts and the hundreds of expressions of concern, the theater owner not only dug in his heels, refusing to reconsider bringing *Fifty Shades of Grey* into our community, but was also quite hostile in his response, stating in part: "... Just because you do not agree with this type of film doesn't mean others don't. I find it very unchristianlike to push your views/beliefs on others. ... leave your personal beliefs/views for service on Sundays. If you don't like the fact we live in a free country then that is also your issue. ..."

What this theater owner doesn't understand, however, is that with freedom comes responsibility and that at the heart of Christianity is not keeping our faith within the walls of the church, but it is sharing the light we have received through God's grace. Because of love for neighbor we speak out, warn, and express concern regarding that which damages and destroys. Included in my letter to the editor was this:

As a father, grandfather, concerned citizen, committed Christian, and former porn user, I am writing because I know the power that pornography has to worm its way into the heart, soul, and mind of any individual. ...

Pornography destroys. Statistics, personal testimony, and common sense demonstrate that is true. ...

Part of our ministry's calling has been to warn others of pornographic concerns that are coming into our community and beyond. ...

Even if individuals choose not to watch the film themselves, the culture they find themselves in has been affected and changed by the skewing of love and truth.

"Fifty Shades of Grey" takes the beautiful act of intimacy which God has designed for a husband and wife, an act of love and protection, an act of giving and completing; and warps it into a lust filled act of deviancy where physical pain, selfishness, and insecurity are made out to be the norm. It promotes violence during times of intimacy and the idea that "no" doesn't mean "no."

Our community matters to us.

This is not about censorship. It is about doing what caring parents, grandparents, and communities have done for many years – standing up for what is worthy and decent and opposing that which is degrading and potentially destructive.

We encourage you to join with us in doing just that. ...
