Who's On Your Throne?

The Hollywood Reporter recently detailed an alleged contract which extras (background actors) on HBO's "Westworld" are expected to sign prior to their use in scenes on the upcoming science fiction show.

As THR quips, the consent form "reads like the Kama Sutra," and warns that the actors may be required to "perform genital-to-genital touching," as well as, "pose on all fours while others who are fully nude ride on your back, [and] ride on someone's back while you are both fully nude," among other sexually graphic expectations.

You wouldn't know it from what's expected of the actors, but "Westworld" is based on a 1973 movie by Michael Crichton where robots in a western theme park come to life. The reboot is being billed as, "a dark odyssey about the dawn of artificial consciousness and the future of sin."

Thanks to HBO, we now know that artificial consciousness will lead to naked people riding each other like horses. Who would have thought the future of sin was so unimaginatively carnal?

In an interview with Entertainment Weekly, writer Jonathan Nolan told his potential audience what to expect: "What we can tell you is that we intend to make the most ambitious, subversive, f---ed up television series."

It sounds like they're well on their way, but that title right now arguably belongs to another HBO series. Perhaps you've heard of "Game of Thrones," the fantasy series in which twins have sex by their dead son's grave and a pregnant woman is repeatedly stabbed in the belly, to name just a few of the horrific moments from one of cable television's most popular shows.

The finale of season 5 snatched up 8.1 million viewers, but the total audience across media platforms is close to 20 million.

Earlier this summer, John Piper addressed the question, "should Christians watch Game of Thrones" on his "Ask Pastor John" podcast. One could also ask, "should anyone watch Game of Thrones?" but then one would be accused of censorship, and we certainly wouldn't want that.

Piper's answer is relevant to all television shows and media that Christians take in, and really should be applied to everything a Christian does for entertainment. Here are three of Piper's 12 points.

1. Am I Assuming Nudity Is Necessary for Good Art?

There is no great film or television series that needs nudity to add to its greatness....
There are creative ways to be true to reality without turning sex into a spectator's sport and without putting actors and actresses in morally compromised situations on the set.

... Underneath all of this is male sexual appetite driving this business, and following from that is peer pressure in the industry and the desire for ratings that sell. It is not art that puts nudity in film, it's the appeal of prurience. It sells.

2. Am I Craving Acceptance?

Christians do not watch nudity with a view to maximizing holiness. That is not what keeps them coming back to the shows. They know deep down that these television shows or these movies are shot through with the commendation and exaltation of attitudes and actions that are utterly out of step with the death to self and out of step with exaltation of Christ.

No, what keeps those Christians coming back is the fear that if they take Christ at his word and make holiness as serious as I am saying it is, they would have to stop seeing so many television shows and so many movies, and they would be viewed as freakish. And that today is the worst evil of all. To be seen as freakish is a much greater evil than to be unholy.

3. Am I Free from Doubt?

There is one biblical guideline that makes life very simple: "But whoever has doubts is condemned if he eats, because the eating is not from faith. For whatever does not proceed from faith is sin" (Romans 14:32). My paraphrase: If you doubt, don't. That would alter the viewing habits of millions, and oh how sweetly they would sleep with their conscience.

In a sermon again addressing Christians and entertainment, Piper said something similar.

I am appalled at what Christians do for entertainment by taking it for granted that if it is in the theater it should be watched. I am appalled, not because I am a prude — I have my favorite movies — but because I am ruined by certain scenes. I won't watch certain good movies because of that scene. I will not because Christ is dishonored in my soul and my mind is contaminated for months and he is more precious than the pleasure of the other 124 minutes.

Come on. Let's be Christian through and through. Let's get ready to suffer. If we can't deny ourselves a little bit of entertainment that the world assumes we must have in order for us to know and admire sweetly and more deeply enjoy constant fellowship with our Jesus, how are we going to face the stampede of horses when they come? ... Use everything to enhance your enjoyment of Jesus. And if it doesn't enhance it, don't do it.

And there are certainly shows that are less graphic than "Westwood" and "Game of Thrones," that still do not honor Him. Those are extremes, but even many network TV shows glamorize adultery, homosexuality, and myriad other sinful lifestyles.

Christians must "bring every thought captive to make it obedient to Christ," including, if not *especially*, our entertainment choices.

Do you or your friends and family entertain yourselves with media that hinders your relationship with Christ?

Could a mama cat have a baby elephant?

"Could a mama cat have a baby elephant? Could a chicken hatch a puppy?" These questions were followed by a fit of giggles from my seven-and eight-year-old Sunday School students. "Of course not!" they replied.

I asked the questions in a recent Sunday School lesson leading to a discussion of original sin. As each kind of animal gives birth to their own kind, so the first parents, Adam and Eve, (and all people after them) gave birth to humans with sinful hearts just like their own.

The incredulous response to my questions from my elementary-aged students showed that the laws of nature put in place by God are understood innately – even by children. Yet what is commonsense to a seven-year-old seems to exceed the grasp of those pushing the new morality – forced approval of any and all lifestyles that deviate from natural law and God's design.

In recent months, the Midwives Alliance of North America (MANA) fell to pressure from the LGBT movement and stripped references to the terms "mothers" or "women" from the organization's official guidelines. Midwives who belong to MANA are told to no longer refer to women who give birth as "mothers," but are now required to call them "birthing individuals."

Midwives Alliance of North America claims the use of "mother" and "women" are not inclusive and the change was made to avoid offending those who identify as transgender.

This alliance of midwives seems to think being a woman isn't really necessary to give birth to babies. A notion with which my Sunday School kids might disagree.

A group called "Women-Centered Midwifery" also disagrees and is petitioning MANA to change the policy. Hundreds of regarded midwifery experts, including Ina May Gaskin, the "mother of authentic midwifery," signed a letter to MANA, seeking a return to commonsense.

The letter states in part: "women are now all but missing from the language, as if we can separate woman from mother from baby."

of Women-Centered The midwives Midwifery, who by nature of their profession know where babies come from, go on to remind MANA that one's sex either male or female – is set at conception and is an unchangeable part of our DNA. As they write in their petition: "We know as midwives that biological sex occurs at the level of our DNA and the gametes we produce, and is immutable. Sex is natural, biological and objectively factual. Human beings, like the majority of other mammals, are sexually dimorphic. i.e. there are two distinct biological sexes."

One such as Bruce Jenner may "identify" as a woman, may change everything from his name to his body, yet biologically he is still a male. A woman can in the same way "identify" as a man, yet her biological sex will remain female.

Their letter continues, stating what should be obvious: "by embracing the idea that any human other than those in a class called women carry offspring to term, give birth to them and nurse them, we are prioritizing gender identity over biological reality. We are allowing gender identity to be the primary way that we refer to one another, even for a biological process like birth.

"The very few gender-identified males that have given birth ... have only done so because they are female-bodied people, and that scientific fact cannot be erased."

This push by MANA to eliminate the term "mother" is another assault upon the design of marriage and family.

Words matter. Definitions matter. There is a great danger in attempting to change the meaning of words.

German dictionaries today contain a qualifying bracket after certain words with the abbreviation "N.S." referring to National Socialist – the Nazi party of World War II era. The Nazis attempted to change the meanings of words and the N.S. notation now designates that definition as Nazi propaganda.

Governments can unilaterally dictate that what is square shall henceforth be called round. A majority of the population may even vote to affirm that a square is actually a circle, but it doesn't change the reality.

Yet changing reality is what those such as MANA are systematically trying to do.

In California the "outdated" language of 'husband and wife' has been eliminated from state laws and Florida has removed the terms 'bride' and 'groom' from marriage licenses, replaced with 'spouse' and 'spouse.'

Playboy and the passe

What pops into your head when you hear the word "Playboy?"

Yeah, me too. Well, the magazine just announced that starting next March, they won't have that anymore.

The magazine that opened "Pandora's box" (Hugh Hefner's words) on our culture's acceptance, and really integration, of pornography in everyday life will no longer feature naked women.

Did the infamous editor and original Playboy, Hugh Hefner, have a "come-to-Jesus" moment? Did he finally realize the devastation that his publication has done to the nation's moral fiber?

Alas, no, though hope is never lost for Hefner's depraved soul.

Playboy executives have reached the bittersweet realization that, "That battle has been fought and won. You're now just one click away from every sex act imaginable for free. And so it's just passé at this juncture."

Pat yourselves on the back, Playboy, you've made nudity passé!

In an interview with the Gospel Coalition, author and psychology professor William Struthers expounded on the publication's legacy, "Nearly six decades ago it began cultivating an appetite for sexual images that has grown hungrier and now is ravenous across our culture. Interestingly, the culture now no longer has a taste for what Playboy has to offer."

Do you doubt the cultural influence of porn? Take a look at these statistics:

- * Every second \$3,075.64 is being spent on pornography and 28,258 internet users are viewing porn.
- * 40 Million Americans are regular visitors to porn sites. 1 in 3 porn viewers are women. 70% of men aged 18-24 visit porn sites in a typical month
- * In the US, Internet porn pulls in \$2.84 Billion per year. The entire worldwide industry is worth \$4.9 Billion.
- * 25% of all search engine requests are pornography related. That's 68 Million a day.
- *35% of all internet downloads are pornographic.
- * There are 116,000 searches for "child pornography" every day.
- * The average age at which a child first sees porn online is 11.
- * 20% of men admit to watching porn online at work and 13% of women do.
- * The least popular day of the year for viewing porn is Thanksgiving. The most popular day of the week for viewing porn is Sunday.

No wonder Playboy can't keep up! They had better be working on some very interesting articles!

So, sixty-three years ago Hugh Hefner began bringing pornography in out of the cold - from the shame swathed peepshows and sketchy theaters to the living rooms of nearly 8 million households (in its hay day)

Once the "centerfold" was established as the trophy of the modern gentleman, or the small "p" playboy, she moved on to selling beer and then on to selling everything from Abercrombie clothes to Carl's Jr. burgers.

Now she takes up a healthy (or unhealthy) swath of the internet and a tragic amount of internet users', i.e. almost everyone's, time.

As the sexual revolution unfolded, those who wished to protect the dignity of womanhood have been labeled "prudes," while those who have cheered the cultural strip show have been seen as "empowering" women.

Playboy's announcement, however, justifies the "prude's" position. Playboy distancing itself from its legacy of attractive naked women is evidence that the sexual revolution has disempowered women. **Sex no longer sells.**

What is interesting, is that Playboy is not the first, though it is the most iconic, company to turn on that most famous maxim of marketing.

Abercrombie and Fitch recently backed off their infamously sexy advertising campaign. Budweiser commercials now feature an adorable golden retriever. GoDaddy, once the bad boy of the Super Bowl ad lineup, put their sexy spokeswoman in a manly body suit and surrounded her with bodybuilders in last year's commercial.

Any power that women found in being able to sell a product, or even turn a man's head, is waning. Ladies, Playboy popularized porn, and porn has made you passé.

Playboy's radical decision would seem like good news, on one level, but as Albert Mohler has pointed out, "A theology that rejects the "biblical God" and any notion of divine judgment or the afterlife is integral to the Playboy Philosophy, and the overthrow of Christianity as a belief system precedes the rejection of Christian sexual morality. And all this came as Hugh Hefner made millions exploiting women and mainstreaming pornography...

Hefner's moral philosophy and its underlying theology are now mainstream in America, and the current Playboy CEO can claim "that battle has been fought and won."

What you should hear in that claim of victory is the fall of an entire civilization and the moral consensus that made that civilization possible. Any morally sane person must recognize that as horrifyingly had news, indeed."

As the culture around us makes bland the excitement of sexuality, let us continue to hold its value as one of God's great gifts, and let us pray that our culture catches on.

One Name – and It isn't Allah

God Bless you! It's a common courtesy said millions of times a day – especially during allergy season.

Presidents have long closed speeches and State of the Union addresses with a similar statement – usually "God Bless you and God Bless these United States of America" – or some variation of the theme. And, if you're not out of your seat getting a hotdog, it's common practice to go from singing "Take Me Out to the Ballgame" to "God Bless America" during the 7th inning stretch at major league baseball games.

Who would have thought that a sentiment which is a daily part of American life - two little words, "God Bless" — would cause some to go into apoplectic fits. Yet that is exactly what is happening in case after case all across the country.

"God bless the military, their families, and the civilians who work with them" reads a sign that has stood at Marine Corps Base Hawaii for 14 years. Yet now that sign honoring those who serve and their families is being targeted by anti-Christian activist, Mikey Weinstein, who makes it his mission to drive any vestige of Christianity out of the military. Through the organization he founded, Military Religious Freedom Foundation, Weinstein has a long history of filing suits against the military in regards to any innocuous reference to Christianity.

Weinstein told a Honolulu newspaper, the sign stands out "like a tarantula on a wedding cake."

Weinstein might get a high mark in the use of creative imagery, but he fails at Constitution 101. In a letter to Col. Sean C. Killeen, the base commanding officer, Mikey Weinstein's organization wrote: "This sign is a brazen violation of the No Establishment clause of the Constitution, as it sends the clear message that your installation gives preference to those who hold religious beliefs over those who do not, ..."

Yet Colonel Ron Crews, executive director of the Chaplain Alliance for Religious Liberty, told OneNewsNow: "Only someone with a great misunderstanding of the First Amendment or an axe to grind against religion would claim that such a slogan poses a threat or is in any way unconstitutional. The real threat is posed by those who want to whitewash any reference to God from public discourse – even ones as innocuous and uplifting as this one."

As Alliance Defending Freedom so aptly wrote to the base commander, "The Establishment Clause does not provide a heckler's veto to those who find offense. MRFF and its members are entitled to feel offense, but it is part of living in a pluralistic military community."

Yet it's not just the military coming under attack for the usage of "God Bless."

Last year a high school girl in Tennessee was sent to the principal's office and ultimately received in-school suspension. Her offense? Saying "God bless you" when someone in class sneezed.

This is not an isolated incident in America's public schools.

A Louisiana high School principal is currently being targeted by the ACLU because he ended a letter posted on the school's website with this inspirational closing: "The Future Starts Today – May God Bless You All."

The ACLU claims that simple use of God's name was a promotion of Christianity.

As Louisiana Representative Mike Johnson stated, "This is typical of the ACLU. They're on a seek-and-destroy mission for all things religious." However, it's not all

things "religious" that the ACLU is seeking to eliminate – just all things Christian.

The ACLU claims, as they wrote to the superintendent of this Louisiana school district: "The United States Constitution requires public schools to ensure that state-supported activity is not used for religious indoctrination." Yet where is their opposition to the state-supported religious indoctrination of Islam within public schools and the use of the name of "Allah"?

School districts all across the country are teaching the Five Pillars of Islam as part of their curriculum, but "God bless you" is considered "indoctrination" by the ACLU.

In Spring Hill, TN many parents are rightfully upset after their middle school children were forced to write "Allah in the only God" as part of a lesson about Islam. Hindu and Buddhism will also be studied, but there is no mention of Jesus or Christianity. As one mother voiced her concern: "For them to spend three weeks on Islam after having skipped Christianity, it seems to be that they are making a choice about which religion to discuss."

And nearly 1,500 parents are joining forces in a Georgia school district to protest the indoctrination of Islam and the neglect of Christianity within the curriculum. As one upset parent stated: "My daughter had to learn the Shiad, and the five pillars of Islam, which is what you learn to convert, but they never once learned anything about the Ten Commandments or anything about God."

This same curriculum even teaches that Allah is the same god worshiped by Christians and Jews.

However, there is only one God and His name certainly isn't Allah. It is His blessing we seek for our nation.

Yet when our nation's institutions are banned from seeking His blessing and even mentioning His name, it may very well be His judgment that we receive.

And the trend doesn't stop with marriage licenses. The country of Spain, changed birth certificates from 'Father' and 'Mother' to 'Progenitor A' and 'Progenitor B.' And a California bill allows for three parents to be listed on a birth certificate – mother, father, and parent. A feat that would baffle not only my Sunday School students, but any student of biology.

As Christian commentator Michael Brown reports: "as England began to move towards redefining marriage, the Daily Telegraph reported that, "The word 'husband' will in the future be applied to women and the word 'wife' will refer to men, the Government has decided."

According to John Bingham, "Civil servants have overruled the Oxford English Dictionary and hundreds years of common usage effectively abolishing the traditional meaning of the words for spouses."

In the government's proposed guidelines, "'husband' here will include a man or a woman in a same sex marriage, as well as a man married to a woman. In a similar way, 'wife' will include a woman married to another woman or a man married to a man."

So, a man could be a wife if married to another man (or not), while a woman could be a husband if married to another woman (or not), all of which begs the question: Why use words at all if they have utterly lost their meaning?
