### They are ringing their "Liberty Bell"! Will we ring

This morning (October 23), word came that Hong Kong had officially withdrawn the extradition bill. The bill put the Hong Kongers at risk of being sent to mainland China to face Communist Party controlled courts which prompted protests that engulfed the territory in months of escalating conflict between citizens and the police. An extradition to Beijing is seen as doomsday – forget ever being seen again in this earthly world.

Despite the massive risks facing them, Hong Kongers young and old continue to take to the streets in protest - putting their lives on the line.

Comments were made this morning by Sandy Rios on American Family Radio that Hong Kong youth are like American youth in that they are living "the good life" – the abundance of things, nice clothes, money, education and careers – yet despite recognizing that - they are willing to risk losing all of it: their life, limb and anonymity all in the name of freedom. Indeed, they are

ringing THEIR liberty bell!

This is a powerful picture of conviction!!! Would you (WILL OUR YOUNG PEOPLE, AS THOSE IN HONG KONG) take a stand against Beijing, against oppression, against a regime that would take away your freedom of religion, your right to bear arms, your inalienable rights?

You may recall, and the media regularly reminds us that in 1997, the British handed Hong Kong back to China, the end of a 99 year long lease and an event that was anticipated and dreaded by the residents. But the agreement was that Hong Kong would remain a semi-autonomous region for 50 years after the lease ended – extending to 2047). However, China is exerting increased levels of brutality to undermine this agreement, exerting its authority in order to press Hong Kong under its Communistic hegemony, denying the freedoms they've long enjoyed.

Here are some of the excesses of Communist China: forced organ harvesting of political and religious dissidents, a one child policy and its practice of infanticide, over 6,000 crosses have been burned or ripped down from church buildings. Crosses inside churches are now being required to be flanked by portraits of Mao Zedong and Xi Jinping. And unprecedentedly, the Chinese government has begun to use mass surveillance technology, artificial

intelligence, big data, and a new "social credit system" to persecute the church.

By 2020, 600 million CCTV cameras - nearly one for every 2 Chinese citizens - will blanket China. They are being forcibly installed inside church buildings to record 24/7 the entrances, stairwells, offering boxes, and Bible counters. Using face recognition technology and big data, including from mobile phones and social media, the Chinese government will soon track virtually every social movement and behavior of all of its citizens, including who attends church, buys Bibles, and where those Bibles are taken. When people like NBA superstar Lebron James of the Los Angeles Lakers, Golden State Warriors Coach Steven Kerr, and Antonio Spurs coach Gregg Popovich become American lightning rods for what is the societal standard for the freedom of speech, we are on the path of destruction.

You likely now have read ad nauseam of the degradation that has gained a stronghold at a tweet that simply read: "Fight for Freedom. Stand with Hong Kong" posted by Daryl Morey, the general manager of the Houston Rockets.

Two days later, the NBA issued the following statement: "We recognize that the views expressed by Houston Rockets General Manager Daryl Morey have deeply offended many of our friends and fans in China, which is regrettable ... We have great respect for the history and culture of China and hope that sports and the NBA can be used as a unifying force to bridge cultural divides and bring people together."

Thus began the push back on unsuspecting general manager Daryl Morey. Within a short period of time, Morey withdrew his tweet. Nonetheless in the aftermath, all of China's partners for the NBA and Houston Rockets suspended ties with the league and team.

James Gorrie writes at the <u>Epoch Times</u>, Sadly, Rockets teammates James Harden and Russell Westbrook couldn't find it within themselves to support either Morey or the people of Hong Kong. Instead, they issued a joint statement to the Chinese government: "We apologize ... You know, we love China. We love playing there. They show us the most important love."

One has to wonder just what could these two

players possibly mean by "most important love?"

Even the NBA's top player, LeBron James, who earns in excess of \$100 million per year and has a net worth of almost a half-billion dollars, threw the people of Hong Kong under the bus. James went on to explain that "people (meaning the Laker players?) could have been hurt physically or financially hurt" from Morey's tweet. He criticized Morey as not being "educated on the situation at hand."

The situation, for the edification of Mr. James, is rather simple. Hongkongers don't want to be subjugated by the most brutal and oppressive regime on the face of the earth. Therefore, they are fighting against it. ...

The fact is that the NBA does stand to lose a lot of money if they lose the China market. But ... the NBA is not the North American division of China's thought police. Not yet, anyway. ...

More accurately, the CCP is in the business of control. Absolute control. And it will use every engagement with American companies, culture, entertainment and education to incrementally gain control and use it for their own purposes. Their purpose is to dominate the world in every aspect that matters. To do so, they must first eliminate the power and influence of the United States.

There's a reason why the Hongkongers wave American flags and appeal to the United States for help. What other nation in the world is strong enough to defend freedom?

That's why it's so disappointing to see how some of the biggest names in basketball know or care so little about what freedom is, or what it takes to gain and hold onto it. They're letting the world down to put more money in their pockets. Perhaps a stroll in downtown Hong Kong on a Saturday night would help them better understand.....

But really, this isn't about basketball, selling billions of dollars of team merchandise or even about the NBA. It's about the struggle between two political systems and two countries. China is using its huge market as a lure to convince extremely well-paid players and the NBA itself that their interests lie in kneeling before China rather than standing

up for the United States. But it's even more than that. It's nothing less than a battle for civilizational survival.

China is betting that the NBA and its players are all about money. They're testing America's—and Americans'—resolve to stand up for their principles. The CCP's strategy appears to be to reposition the NBA's financial center of gravity to China. To that effect, the message that the Chinese are sending to the NBA and the basketball players is simple: you can get much richer if you play your game on our courts; just shut your mouth and do what we say.

However, rather than give in to China's bully/bribe tactics, perhaps the players, coaches, owners and NBA officials should choose to make a bit less money in exchange for something much more valuable: their integrity in standing for, and yes, defending the greatest of human values.

What's more, it seems that the NBA and its players don't realize the true power they possess. They don't have to give in to China to do well financially. Why not push back against the CCP? #### Bull's-eye on Chick-fil-A

Isaiah 59:15 states, "Truth is lacking, and he who departs from evil makes himself a prey. The LORD saw it, and it displeased him that there was no justice." When Chick-fil-A took a stand for Biblical values regarding traditional marriage, they essentially painted a bull's-eye on their back. Since that time LGBTQ culture warriors have taken shots at them by denying them access to their university campuses, boycotting, and wrongfully accusing the chicken chain of hate while themselves using hate-filled speech and foul language.

It should be no surprise that Chick-fil-A stands where it does on the marriage issue; being Biblical has been their goal. They are closed on Sundays, they help those that are in need, and Dan Cathy, son of Chick-fil-A founder Truett Cathy, states that his marketplace goal is "to take biblical truth and put skin on it.... We're talking about how our performance in the workplace should be the focus of how we build respect, rapport, and relationships with others that opens the gateway to interest people in knowing God."

I remind our readers of these things to help us recognize that the accusations the Left throws our way aren't necessarily truthful, just accusations. Although we often hear "feeling statements" about how hateful Chick-fil-A is, the factual statements - actual events - that are reported reflect a fast-food chain that is compassionate, loving, and kind.

One of the most recent hate-mongering statements regarding Chick-fil-A comes from Steven Corbett, principal of Louisiana's Lusher High School, who turned down Chick-fil-A's offer to provide a free lunch to the school's teachers. It was to be provided through the College Football Playoff Foundation (CFPF) in gratitude to the New Orleans community for hosting the Sugar Bowl and College Football Championship in 2020.

Principal Corbett stated that Chick-fil-A's values do not align with those of the school. "Out of respect to our LGBTQ staff, we have chosen to not serve Chick-fil-A at an employee lunch. The #1 rule at Lusher is to 'Be Kind' and we live this motto every day." Chick-fil-A has been politically outspoken about its views, and we feel it is not part of Lusher's culture of kindness and community." The principal went on to say, "Anytime an organization is anti-LGBTQ, and has efforts to infringe upon their rights, we thought it was important to support and stand up for their community at this time."

What Principal Corbett, and so many others, say about Chick-fil-A isn't true. Although they believe in Biblical/traditional marriage, they don't discriminate; they will serve and help anyone. They don't attempt to infringe upon the rights of the LGBTQ community; they've only stated their position on this cultural/Biblical issue. In July of 2012, The New American reported, "For its own part, Chick-fil-A appears ready to move beyond the controversy sparked by Cathy's comments [on traditional marriage]. In a July 19th statement the chain said that 'going forward, our intent is to leave the policy debate over same-sex marriage to the government and political arena.' The statement said that the company would continue its policy of treating 'every person with honor, dignity and respect regardless of their belief, race, creed, sexual orientation, or gender.'"

Regarding this current matter with Lusher High School, a spokesperson for Chickfil-A gave this statement:

"We are a restaurant company focused on food and hospitality and have no political or social agenda. Our priority is on providing a welcoming and respectful environment for our guests and Team Members." God has honored this fast-food chain that has honored Him. Regardless the attacks and denial of franchise location; even though they are only open six days a week; in spite of the boycotts and this company's habit of going out of the way to help those in need; Chick-fil-A reported over \$10 billion in revenue in 2018.

What about you and me? When we face opposition will we "take biblical truth and put skin on it"? In other words, will we realize that "he who departs from evil makes himself a prey;" then depart from evil anyway?

In doing so, are we willing to take those Biblical and holy stands and then follow Jesus' command to "love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you"? After all, that IS the call of the Christian.

Another call of the Christian is to speak the truth in love. We urge you to contact Principal Steve Corbett at steven corbett@lusherschool.org and let him know that his actions are inconsistent with his stated "culture of kindness." Inform him that to disagree with another's ideology is not the same thing as hatred or infringing upon the other's rights. If that were the case then he would be infringing upon the rights of Chick-fil-A and every person who stands for traditional marriage. Tell him that as principal of a high school he should be setting an example of learning how to disagree with others respectfully, much as Chick-fil-A has done.

Although most of the Left will not respond in kind, ours is to be a conversation that is God-honoring, remembering that we ourselves are flawed, and that we're dealing with image-bearers of God who are distorted and may not even recognize the God whose image they bear.

I don't remember a time that I didn't know Christ or hadn't heard of Him. I am grateful for the training that my parents and my church gave me.

I did go through a time in later years that I wondered about my salvation - not that I ever doubted Christ, but I wanted that reassurance – a piece of paper, per se, that gave me the assurance that my name was written in the Book of Life. I am grateful that I had Christian people to talk with about my faith in God and the assurance that I needed.

My parents have always been active in our church - from being Sunday school teachers, ushers, Awana leaders, to helping do things behind the scenes - and taught me the importance of being involved in the local church. on these various topics and that they are thinking of it from a Christian worldview. I pray that they will continue on their quest for knowledge of Christ, as we all should be in the Word daily.

#### Who's Fiddling While China Burns?

The technological development of 5G is inevitable; the question is, "Who's going to control the infrastructure?" Huawei is spearheading the CCP's agenda for the world. That agenda is to promote the tyrannical model of an abusive surveillance state against the American model of peace, liberty, and inalienable rights. #### Raising the Barr for Religious Liberty

Elections have consequences. President Obama and his Attorney General Eric Holder saw religious liberty as an obstacle to their leftist agenda. Rather than defend the first freedom protected by the Constitution – they sought to undermine religious liberty at every turn. Just ask the Little Sisters of the Poor.

What a difference with President Trump's Attorney General, William Barr. Barr recently spoke at Notre Dame University where he gave an incredibly powerful defense not only of religious liberty, but of the ramifications when Christian influence is diminished in society. Where religious expression was once seen as vital to society, it's now seen as a threat to advancing the leftist agenda. Just recently, presidential candidate Beto O'Rourke threatened to tax churches if they refused to embrace homosexual marriage.

Yet, as William Barr pointed out, the Constitutional protection of religious freedom reflects the Framers' belief that religion was indispensable to sustaining our free system of government. As Barr stated: [The Founding Fathers] never thought the main danger to the republic came from external foes. The central question was whether, over the long haul, we could handle freedom. The question was whether the citizens in such a free society could maintain the moral discipline and virtue necessary for the survival of free institutions. ...

The answer to that question is becoming increasingly clear. The Founders recognized the truth spelled out in God's Word, "the heart is deceitful above all things," and

unless bridled by "morality and religion," as John Adams put it, the Constitution would not stand against man's deceit. And not just any religion, as Barr makes clear throughout his address, **Christianity was the moral foundation upon which this nation was built.** So, if "morality and religion" are undermined, what will be the restraining force against man's propensity for evil?

As Barr explained: But, if you rely on the coercive power of government to impose restraints, this will inevitably lead to a government that is too controlling, and you will end up with no liberty, just tyranny.

On the other hand, unless you have some effective restraint, you end up with something equally dangerous – licentiousness – the unbridled pursuit of personal appetites at the expense of the common good. This is just another form of tyranny – where the individual is enslaved by his appetites, and the possibility of any healthy community life crumbles.

Leftists place their hope in government, not God. And when government becomes god, that government won't protect religious liberty – rather it will see religion as a threat to its own power. And when people deny their Creator and become a god unto themselves, they won't defend another's right to believe in an Authority who sits in judgment over mankind. Therefore, as Barr stated, over the past 50 years religion has been under increasing attack. ...

So as Christian influence is driven from society and replaced with moral relativism, what are the consequences? Barr spells it out in graphic detail. In 1965, the illegitimacy rate was eight percent. In 1992 ... it was 25 percent. Today it is over 40 percent. In many of our large urban areas, it is around 70 percent. ...

Suffice it to say that the campaign to destroy the traditional moral order has brought with it immense suffering, wreckage, and misery. And yet, the forces of secularism, ignoring these tragic results, press on with even greater militancy. Among these militant secularists are many so-called "progressives." But where is the progress? We are told we are living in a post-Christian era. But what has replaced the Judeo-Christian moral system? What is it that can fill the spiritual void in the hearts of the individual person? And what is a system of values that can sustain human social life?

The fact is that no secular creed has emerged capable of performing the role of religion.

What are the results when a society looks to government to fulfill the role of religion? Barr spells out the ramifications. So the reaction to growing illegitimacy is not sexual responsibility, but abortion. The reaction to drug addiction is safe injection sites. The solution to the breakdown of the family is for the State to set itself up as the ersatz husband for single mothers and the ersatz father to their children.

The call comes for more and more social programs to deal with the wreckage. While we think we are solving problems, we are underwriting them. We start with an untrammeled freedom and we end up as dependents of a coercive state on which we depend.

However, this moral freefall hasn't happened on its own. Rather, Barr asserts, there is a concerted effort by the Left to undermine the influence of Christianity in the culture.

... Secularists, and their allies among the "progressives," have marshaled all the force of mass communications, popular culture, the entertainment industry, and academia in an unremitting assault on religion and traditional values. ...

More recently, we have seen the law used aggressively to force religious people and entities to subscribe to practices and policies that are antithetical to their faith.

The problem is not that religion is being forced on others. The problem is that irreligion and secular values are being forced on people of faith.

Similarly, militant secularists today do not have a live and let live spirit - they are not content to leave religious people alone to practice their faith. Instead, they seem to take a delight in compelling people to violate their conscience.

The examples are endless of wedding vendors, doctors, teachers, sportscasters, first responders, businessmen, and artists who have lost their livelihood and have been figuratively burned at the stake for refusing to bow to the secular orthodoxy.

Barr concludes with this challenge: I do not mean to suggest that there is no hope for moral renewal in our country. But we cannot sit back and just hope the pendulum is going to swing back toward sanity. ... And we know that the first thing we have to do to promote renewal is to ensure that we are putting our principles into practice in our own personal private lives. ...

This is tough work. It is hard to resist the constant seductions of our contemporary society. This is where we need grace, prayer, and the help of our church.

Beyond this, we must place greater emphasis on the moral education of our children. ... We cannot have a moral renaissance unless we succeed in passing to the next generation our faith and values in full vigor.

We must be vigilant to resist efforts by the forces of secularization to drive religious viewpoints from the public square and to impinge upon the free exercise of our faith.

I can assure you that, as long as I am Attorney General, the Department of Justice will be at the forefront of this effort, ready to fight for the most cherished of our liberties: the freedom to live according to our faith.

#### **Transition Inquisition**

When Galileo, facing an inquisition, was forced to recant the truth that the earth revolves around the sun - he purportedly said in defiance, "and yet it moves."

Today many are facing their own inquisition regarding the truth of gender. In Texas, a father lost his bid for custody of his 7-year-old son, James, for trying to protect him from chemical castration and gender transition therapy that the boy's mother is pushing upon the child. And now the boy's father can't even do that. Reportedly, the court has instructed the father that he may not address his son by his given name, James, and may not refer to him as a boy.

Thankfully, after a public outcry when conservative news sites reported on the case (while the mainstream media ignored it), the

judge has amended the initial custody ruling which gave full custody to the mother, and is now allowing the father to have joint conservatorship over James, which includes making joint medical decisions for him.

However, this case should be a wakeup call. "Every Republican-controlled state should be introducing legislation to make medical transition for minors illegal and provide clear parental rights for both the mother and the father in disputes over the child's sexuality," writes Chad Greene at the Federalist. "We have tolerated this far too long in the hope sanity would win out on its own. We have failed these children."

And as Al Mohler comments: It is honestly just very hard to imagine how we could have reached this point of mass delusion in the United States of America. We are now unable or are too intimidated to use words like "boy" and "girl" in their only sensical context. ...

Over the span of history, there are significant moments that stand out, upon reflection, as indicators of an historical hinge. ... This decision, and the fact that we were all called to a massive self-delusion socially about it, that legal force was brought for coercion against a parent, we now understand this redefinition of the family and what will be done to this child as a result of this decision, that that was one of those historical hinges. ...

We're now told that we are, and we have to be, a society in which we all just consider it normal for drag queens to perform at story hour for children at public libraries, that it makes sense for seven-year-old children to be told that they can indeed transition to a new gender identity. ...

While the secular forces of culture seek to demand that we affirm what is not true that a boy can be a girl - may God's people boldly state, 'and yet he is a boy.' Just as the earth cannot change its God-ordained orbit, so we cannot change our God-designed gender. Stand firm against the forces that seek to undermine Biblical truth – and pray for James and children like him, that they will be protected from this madness.
