Responding to God's leading Needing God's helping hand

Questions and Answers

Question: There are so many spiritual battle fronts today. How do you determine what to involve yourselves in, in the ministry of American Decency?

Answer: I believe that as we faithfully abide in His Word and in prayer and at the same time keep an ear to the culture, we listen for God's leading and direction as to which issues we should tackle. Sometimes God's leading comes as an outrage, sometimes as a burden. We do not take the responsibility lightly.

Jan and I discovered even back in the 1970s (we are in our mid-sixties), the significance of getting up early in the morning and spending time in prayer and devotion. We often are up at 5:00 am. We read the Bible. I daily read devotionals of C.H. Spurgeon, C.S. Lewis, J.C. Ryle and Oswald Chambers.

Confronting the culture has become more difficult today. There is so much wickedness all about us. The television has almost nothing to offer that is edifying.

This fall as new television programs premiere we will again have foisted on us new levels of degradation. One example, NBC will be featuring a new program, "The Playboy Club."

The battle rages on and on. Our prayer whether spoken or unspoken is "Father God what would you have us to do?"

Question: What direction are you sensing that God would have you take in the days ahead?

Answer: Please read this with care and prayerfulness as we are about to go down a little different path for a season. As I unfold this, please know that I seek your help in this through prayers, recommendations and financial support.

We are calling this a joint voter mobilization project of American Decency and Vision America (headed by Pastor Rick Scarborough out of Texas).

<u>Phase 1:</u> To meet with and recruit a sterling and high profile "Host Committee" for the Pastor events and to meet with potential underwriters.

The Host Committee will be pastors who are known for preaching the word boldly and graciously in their communities. We will be engaged in recruiting these pastors to assist us in recruiting like-minded pastors throughout Michigan (at this time).

<u>Phase two:</u> Select key cities and sites for the first series of Pastor Meetings to recruit Patriot Pastors who will "stand up; speak up; and refuse to give up!" in our effort to restore our nation to its original ideals.

Recruitment of Patriot Pastors

- 1. Place a four-fold commitment card in the hands of every Senior Pastor present
- 2. The commitment is:
- a. I will attempt to register every eligible voter in our congregation.
- b. I will preach at least one sermon before Election Day on why Christians should not vote as Republicans or Democrats, but rather as followers of Jesus Christ.
- c. I will make Voter Guides available to my congregation.
- d. I will urge my congregation to vote their values on Election Day.

This is a very brief summary of the plan.

At the meetings, the pastors will be reminded that history shows that in the earlier years of this great nation pastors were involved in preaching against sin and for godliness. This included engaging the culture.

At the meeting, the pastors will be shown that following the steps that we will outline, they do not jeopardize their non-profit status and if threatened by a law suit, we have affiliations with Christian law centers that have never lost in the very few times where there have been complaints filed.

Get out the Vote

- 1. Send out reminders to every Patriot Pastor to follow through with voter registration and voter mobilization.
- 2. Schedule two Michigan Citizenship Sundays to encourage Church participation. Provide preaching materials for participating Patriot Pastors for sermon preparation on these Sundays. Schedule them during the period before the close of Voter Registration in the State.

Can there be any doubt that our Godly heritage is being squandered? We need to call out to God faithfully and humbly in prayer but we also need to take CHRISTIAN action. It is time to call out to pastors, who have the capability of hearing God's voice and who are willing to stand for His Word and live in it, to engage their congregations in calling America back to Him.

In review, you can help by praying, recommending pastors who you think are truly "Patriot Pastors," and by standing with us financially as generously as possible.

Where the Wild Things Are

In the adjacent article, we promote a seminar regarding the ethical crisis in today's society. This crisis was made abundantly clear by recent events in Great Britain and also here in the United States.

Recently British youth, some reportedly as young as nine, have been wreaking havoc on the UK's big cities - setting buildings on fire, destroying property, breaking storefront windows, looting - there have even been people killed.

British columnist Max Hastings discussed the situation in a column for the British "Daily Mail" news website.

"They are essentially wild beasts. I use that phrase advisedly, because it seems appropriate to young people bereft of the discipline that might make them employable; of the conscience that distinguishes between right and wrong. They respond only to instinctive animal impulses — to eat and drink, have sex, seize or destroy the accessible property of others."

He goes on, "The depressing truth is that at the bottom of our society is a layer of young people with no skills, education, values or aspirations. They do not have what most of us would call 'lives': they simply exist... Today, those at the bottom of society behave no better than their forebears, but the welfare state has relieved them from hunger and real want.

When social surveys speak of 'deprivation' and 'poverty', this is entirely relative. Meanwhile, sanctions for wrongdoing have largely vanished."



Asked about the motivation for the looting, one looter explained that they were showing "the rich" and the police that they could "do what they like."

Christian leaders have been saying for years that America is just several years behind Europe socially. Europe has broken the ice on raising kids in schools which teach that there is no moral anchor, only different beliefs that must all be equally respected, and that it's the responsibility of the taxpayers as a whole, not as individuals, to take care of the less fortunate.

That's how England opened the door to the mess it's in now. Neither their upbringing, nor the rules of society imposed by having to be a decent human being in order to get a job have forced Britain's brats to adhere to even the most basic and accepted moral principles.

Max Hastings continues his analysis.

"Of course it is true that few have jobs, learn anything useful at school, live in decent homes, eat meals at regular hours or feel loyalty to anything beyond their local gang.

This is not, however, because they are victims of mistreatment or neglect.

It is because it is fantastically hard to help such people, young or old, without imposing a measure of compulsion which modern society finds unacceptable. These kids are what they are because nobody makes them be anything different or better."

If Europe has broken the ice on this problem, America has gleefully skated into the hole. The following excerpts from a recent Fox News story could be right out of the London Times. [http://fxn.ws/mblrwQ]

... Called "flash robs," these crimes are being organized by young teenagers through various social media outlets, most notably Twitter. Police say the suspects select a time and place and enter the store in droves taking what they want and leaving before security or police can catch them. Some of the most brazen robberies take place in the light of day and on busy streets despite all the security cameras and the watchful eyes of workers."

Here's a look at some of these crimes.

Chicago

... four violent assaults and robberies occurred in Chicago's upscale area of Streeterville. One man was dragged into the street and beaten by a group of 15 to 20 teenage males after a baseball was thrown so hard at his head that his motor-scooter helmet was knocked off. Another man was robbed of his cell phone and camera after being knocked off his bike and punched by a group of teenage males...

Washington, D.C.

On April 25, G Star Raw, workers at a retail store in Dupont Circle were caught off guard as a group of about 20 teenagers swarmed the store, stopping to look through sizes, taking over \$20,000 worth of merchandise and promptly exiting the building...

Las Vegas

In May, 20 teens were caught on camera as they robbed a convenience store and stole about \$600 worth of merchandise and the clerk's cellphone. ... "It became a feeding frenzy," store owner Jon Athney told KLASTV. "They were in the store for three minutes and 30 seconds. ... It's a pretty scary thing...

Max Hastings' description of these kids as "wild beasts" reminded me of some of my favorite books.

In C.S. Lewis' <u>Chronicles of Narnia</u>, Aslan, the Christ figure, chooses animals who will receive the gifts of speech. He tells them "Creatures, I give you yourselves. I give to you forever this land of Narnia. I give you the woods, the fruits, the rivers. I give you

the stars and I give you myself. The dumb beasts whom I have not chosen are yours also, <u>but do not go back to their ways lest</u> you cease to be Talking Beasts."

To unravel Lewis' allegory, God gives his people many good things, including their own selves and Himself and the dominion over the dumb animals, with the caveat that they don't act like dumb animals themselves.

As Lewis explains in a later book, "Everyone of them had been taught - when only a chick or a puppy or a cub - how Aslan at the beginning of the world had turned the beasts of Narnia into Talking Beasts and warned them that if they weren't good they might one day be turned back again and be like the poor witless animals one meets in other countries."

In all of the Chronicles of Narnia, Lewis only describes this happening to one creature, a cat who betrays Aslan and is part of a scheme to enslave the creatures of Narnia.

"What followed was rather horrible. Tirian felt quite certain (and so did the others) that the Cat was trying to say something: but nothing came out of its mouth except the ordinary, ugly cat-noises you might hear from any angry or frightened old Tom in a backyard in England. And the longer he caterwauled, the less like a talking beast he looked."

The cat becomes feral.

Hastings also quotes a London police chief as having called the youth, "feral children." And indeed, they are starting to look more and more like animals, as Hastings describes. "They respond only to instinctive animal impulses — to eat and drink, have sex, seize or destroy the accessible property of others."

Lewis' story drives this point home. Mankind was created to glorify God. That is what separates man from the rest of the animal kingdom, not just opposable thumbs. That is where we find true liberty - within the protective boundary of God's law.

Reading, writing, and perversity

It's back-to-school time in America. If you're of a "certain generation" you probably know the little song, "School days, school days, dear old golden rule days. Readin' and 'ritin' and 'rithmetic, taught to the tune of the hickory stick ..."

Little of that applies to today's public schools. The paddle was banned long ago. The golden rule has been replaced with moral relativism where there is no right or wrong, and the "three Rs" seem to take a back seat to sex ed, "diversity" training, and the promotion of all things homosexual.

The agenda of public schools today is made graphically clear with this recent report regarding a school district in New Jersey:

A New Jersey school district has apologized to parents after requiring high school students to read books that include graphic depictions of lesbian sex and a homosexual orgy.

"Some of the language is inappropriate," said Chuck Earling, superintendent of Monroe Township Schools in Williamstown, N.J. "We were not trying to create controversy. We were just trying to get students to read."

The books were on a required summer reading list for middle school and high school students. The district decided to pull the book off the list, with the start of school just days away.

"There were some words and language that seemed to be inappropriate as far as the parents and some of the kids were concerned," Earling said.

One book, "Norwegian Wood," was on a list for incoming sophomores in an honors English class. The book includes a graphic depiction of a lesbian sex scene between a 31-year-old woman and a 13-year old girl, according to a report first published in the Gloucester County Times.

"Idon'tthinkthat's relevant for any teenager," parent Robin Myers told the newspaper. Her daughter was assigned to read the book. "I was just kind of in shock," she said.

The other book in question was "Tweak (Growing up on Methamphetamines)." That book included depictions of drug usage and a homosexual orgy.

"That has created a controversy," Earling told Fox News Radio, referring to the drug usage – along with the lesbian and gay sex scenes. "We've pulled them from our summer reading list." ...

So whose idea was it to put books featuring explicit sex scenes on a summer reading list for teenagers?

Earling said the school district's summer reading list was prepared by a committee made up of teachers, librarians and school administrators. The board of education ultimately approved the list.

"They read the books," he said. "They didn't feel it was inappropriate based on the language that's used, common language used on the street." The superintendent said students have seen more graphic things on television or in the movies ... http://www.foxnews.com

I don't know what is more disturbing, the fact that these books apparently sailed through an approval process of teachers, librarians, administrators, and the school board or the fact that the superintendent is still defending such trash! He's like a child apologizing because he got caught — not because he's seen the error of his ways.

Notice the superintendent's choice of words and statements in the article above. "There were some words and language that seemed to be inappropriate as far as the parents and some of the kids were concerned."

"Seemed" inappropriate?? For just some of the kids?? And notice

it "seemed" inappropriate to parents - <u>not</u> to the educators!

Remember, we are not talking about a bit of innuendo. These books featured pedophilia – sex between a 31 year old and a 13 year old - which is criminal no matter what the sex of the persons involved. And the books also glorified drug usage and depicted a homosexual orgy. Yet the educators in this district "didn't feel it was inappropriate" - claiming that it's okay to expose their students to such material because Hollywood also does it!

Such rationale is completely absurd. Perhaps today's schools should add some old-fashioned proverbs to their curriculum – such as "two wrongs don't make a right." But then they would have to know what is actually wrong and what is right.

And while far too many youth are exposed to sexualized themes in television, music, and movies, many parents still do protect their children from entertainment choices that give immoral messages. Is it too much to expect schools to do the same – or at least to not undermine that protection?

This example is indicative of the mindset of the education establishment whose radical leadership follows the philosophy of "freedom to read, freedom to view" – that nothing should be off limits from children in the guise of "education." This liberal view sees protecting young, impressionable minds from graphic sexual content as so-called "censorship" and they the educators – not parents – supposedly know what's best for children.

This example should be a warning to parents who have no other option but to place their children in public schools to be ever vigilant in what your children are exposed to. Get involved and don't be afraid to speak out.

There is a war waging for the hearts and minds of our children. Parents and grandparents must be engaged in this battle. Will we teach our youth what is "inappropriate" or will we allow a radical educational establishment to do it for us?
