# Are we in the final stage of Muslim Brotherhood Insurgency?

Perhaps you've heard the ancient proverb, *"The enemy of my enemy is my friend."* It implies that two opposing groups can work together against a common enemy.

We see that maxim playing out before our eyes as leftist, pro-homosexual groups align with Islamic, anti-homosexual groups to combat a common enemy. And the common enemy they're seeking to destroy? Freedom. Through overt violence and subversive infiltration, there is a concerted effort to obliterate our freedoms and the Christian values upon which our nation was founded.

Recently I heard former FBI agent John Guandolo (with Understanding the Threat. com) speak of these threats as he was interviewed on Frank Gaffney's daily broadcast. I came away saying to my wife, Jan: "That is the most concerning of Gaffney's interviews that I have heard!"

We are in the final stage of the Muslim Brotherhood insurgency, he stated. What did John Guandolo mean by that very big statement? Is he some kind of a conspiracy theorist? I can readily tell you that he is not. He is, though, highly regarded in the security community, including by Frank Gaffney of The Center for Security Policy.

So what does that mean "We are in the final stage of the Muslim Brotherhood

insurgency? Guandolo explains how the Muslim Brotherhood is following their systematic plan to transform our nation: It begins with training. It begins with organizing and then you get to the point where you do peaceful resistance and then you do more forceful resistance and then you do the hii*jrah (large scale mass migrations). So that's* The way the insurgency how they do it. looks is they get in all aspects of society: the media, the political realm, the educational realm, the law enforcement, the security realm. And as we heard the guy who ran the combating terrorism and technical support office under irregulative warfare for the Pentagon say on national radio a year ago "Muslim Brotherhood controls the National Security decision making process for the United States Government. And, they've done that by getting into our war colleges, The Joint Forces Staff College, The Command Staff College, The Army War College, into the universities where our government officials are trained and they control the message about Islam.

<u>Gaffney</u>: Talk about the left's role in enabling this Islamic movement assault upon America. Their shared goals despite their seeming very different views on things like feminism, homosexuality, and Jews and the like.

<u>Guandolo:</u> What's interesting is the hard left marxists: We see the Socialists Workers Party, the LGBT national movement joined together with Communist Party USA, Black Lives Matter and Antifa with many, many other groups and they are cooperating with the Islamic movement. And, the shared goal is the overthrow of the U.S. Government.

I watched hours of video from both Charlottesville and Seattle and other events like that, and one of the most interesting things was that numerous people on these videos identified themselves as Marxists or Communists and that they want a Communist system so that everybody is taken care of. They want the overthrow of our Constitutional Republic, the implementation of Communism. The Muslims want the overthrow of the government and the implementation of Shariah and a Caliphate.

What I describe is the leading edge now of the violence that we are starting to see. Our assessment at UTT is that this is unlike the other violence we've been seeing. When you put other events in context what's happening in the Islamic movement and what's happening elsewhere with these recent events of violence, our assessment is this is the leading edge of that final stage - of them starting to really ratchet violence up in the immediate future.

Some will say "We've seen these kinds of troubles before - back in the 1960s and early '70s with massive anti-war rallies and students protesting and taking over university and college administration offices. Yet what we're seeing now is vastly different and much more concerning. Their goal is to fundamentally transform our nation.

I feel compelled to warn again and again even though I don't always want to. Sometimes I honestly wonder who cares. It helped to have another former FBI agent state: *"You are a watchman on the wall."* 

It is apparent that there are many (particularly the younger, but not just the younger), who act as if this is just the new normal. I don't see it that way. I believe that God would have me do what I can and sound the alarm!

Another observer from the *Washington Times* is not buying that it is just a passing fad either. Cheryl K. Chumley writing for the *Washington Times* comments:

Don't for one minute think this past week of Charlottesville-tied mayhem has been over a statue of Robert E. Lee.

It's not. It's about power, control and the political course our nation will take as we head into the future.

Don't see the connection? Walk with me.

The clashes in Charlottesville, disgusting as they were — fatal as they proved — were quickly seized upon by a committed far-left that wants nothing more than to A) remove this president from office and B) change the constitutional nature of America's society for one that's ruled by whim and mob voice, rather than law and order. Charlottesville was the perfect confluence of hot emotion and irrefutable evil. The neo-Nazi mindset is ugly and white supremacist beliefs, wicked. The torch-bearing protesters angry at the idea of the whitewashing of history that comes with the removal of the Confederate statue didn't help their cause by — well, bearing torches.

The Antifa fascists, Black Lives Matter types and communist-socialist-anarchist thugs who came to Charlottesville weren't exactly innocent players in the clashes that followed; they came to the community with violence on their minds. ...

This is what the left is after; this is the end goal — a complete upheaval of America's republic and uprooting of law and order.

The quest is dark. It would mean the end of America's greatest asset — the fact that our country is built upon the foundation that individual rights come from God, not government. It would leave a nation at moral and political drift, a society in chaos, a wide open door for those with selfish desires to take the reigns of political power. What to do?

## Eliminating the Fearfully and Wonderfully Made

A recent CBS headline boasted: "Iceland is on pace to **virtually eliminate** Down syndrome through abortion."

But they aren't eliminating Down syndrome – **they're eliminating babies.** <u>They're</u> not finding a cure for the chromosomal condition which causes Down syndrome – they're killing those who have it.

In Iceland nearly 100% of babies diagnosed with Down syndrome are killed before birth. And Iceland isn't alone; the statistics are equally chilling in many other "progressive" nations. In Great Britain it's 90%. In the U.S., somewhere between 61 percent and 93 percent of Down babies are "eliminated." In France it's estimated that 96 percent of babies with Down syndrome are killed through abortion.

That doesn't come as much of a surprise considering that last year the State Council in France banned an ad produced for World Down Syndrome Day which showed the meaningful, happy lives of children with Down syndrome. As Alexandra DeSanctis of National Review writes: The advertisement was meant to comfort mothers who received a prenatal diagnosis and assure them that their children would have beautiful, largely normal lives. The ad was forbidden by the French government because the smiles of the children would "disturb the conscience of women who had lawfully made different personal life choices" — in other words, because seeing them happy would upset women who had aborted their Down syndrome children.

The vast majority of Down babies are killed before they have a chance to laugh or hug. Anyone who has had the privilege of knowing a person with Down syndrome knows the joy they exude. As the Daily Signal reports, Dr. Brian Skotko, who co-leads the Down Syndrome Program at Massachusetts General Hospital, has shown through his research that:

\* 99 percent of people with Down syndrome are happy.

\* 97 percent of people with Down syndrome like their identity.

\* 99 percent of parents love their child with Down syndrome.

\* 97 percent of brothers and sisters, ages 9-11, say they love their sibling.

Yet the majority of <u>these joy-filled image</u> <u>bearers of God</u> who happen to have an extra chromosome are disposed of.

The "elimination" of those with Down syndrome through abortion - such as what CBS touts - comes straight from Nazi ideology. In 1930s Germany it was called "Lebensunwertes Leben" - which translates, "Life Unworthy of Life." The phrase "life unworthy of life" was the justification to "eliminate" those who the Nazi regime deemed had no right to be alive - they were "unworthy" of life. It began with the mentally impaired - just as is done to Down syndrome babies today. In Nazi Germany those with such disabilities were described as "empty shells of human beings" and were killed through euthanasia. The practice then progressed to other segments of the population who were considered "racially impure" - culminating in the extermination of over 6 million Jews.

Since the riots in Charlottesville, Virginia, we've heard a lot lately about the rise of Neo-Nazism. The media is doing all they can to equate conservatives with these alt-Right nationalists who are spewing hate and bigotry. Yet as we rightfully condemn racism, it's important to note that Nazi ideology is even more prevalent in those on the Left.

The concept of eugenics – the notion of "improving" the human race by eliminating those deemed "unfit" - didn't start with Hitler. It began decades earlier by Leftists such as Margaret Sanger, the founder of Planned Parenthood who started targeting those "unworthy of life" in 1917. Sanger's efforts led to the forced sterilization of more than 60,000 people who she considered "feeble-minded," "idiots," and "morons." In 1920 she wrote: "No more children should be born when the parents, though healthy themselves, find that their children are physically or mentally defective."

In 1926 Sanger spoke at a Ku Klux Klan rally and after which she wrote that she "received a dozen invitations to speak to similar groups." Sanger, the liberal hero that she still is today, wrote in 1939: "We do not want word to go out that we want to exterminate the Negro population, and the minister is the man who can straighten out that idea if it ever occurs to any of their more rebellious members."

Margaret Sanger isn't the only liberal icon with such views. Supreme Court justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg has stated: *"Frankly I had thought that at the time Roe was decided, there was concern about population growth and particularly growth in populations that we don't want to have too many of."* 

And lest you think that Planned Parenthood has abandoned their founder's racist views, statistics from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) show that between 2007 and 2010, nearly 36% of abortions in the U.S. took the lives of black children, even though black Americans make up only 13% of the population. Additionally, 28% of abortions were performed on Hispanics and other minorities. Planned Parenthood's targeting of minorities is revealed in their placement of their abortuaries  $- \underline{79\%}$ of their "clinics" are located within black or Hispanic communities.

While conservatives are labeled as racists, **it's the left who engages in pre-natal lynchings.** Nazi ideology is alive and well in all who look the other way as unborn lives are deemed unworthy of life.

### Swiping Past the World by Chris Johnson



In 2015, Time magazine reported that Americans in aggregate touch their phone 8 billion times per day, or about 46 times per day on average.

A few months later, in **2016**, NetworkWorld. com cited a study claiming that the average user touches their phone **2,617 times each day.** 

If you've ever fallen into the mobile game phenomena "Candy Crush," you may have noticed the claim that sometimes appears on the loading screen, "Players swipe more than two laps around the globe on their mobiles every day!"

An NBC article from 2016 reported that 50% of teens admit to being addicted to their cell phone, while 60% of parents would describe their child in this way.

Of course, even a casual observer doesn't need to see these statistics to realize that mobile devices have become a common, even crucial, piece of modern life.

As a portal to the collective knowledge of mankind - the internet - they are all at once a tool of unequaled usefulness, a means of endless distraction, and an access point to the darkest parts of man's imagination.

Yet, for all of the analysis and statistics and personal experience with smart phone use, there can still be effects that surprise us on occasion.

Which is why, I assume, there have been several published reactions to psychologist Dr. Jean Twenge's recent article at the Atlantic. She makes note of how cell phones and social media have evolved to almost encapsulate or define the teenage experience of the current generation.

In her article, Twenge uses a case study of a 13year-old girl, writing, "She spent much of

her summer keeping up with friends, but nearly all of it was over text or Snapchat. "I've been on my phone more than I've been with actual people," she said. "My bed has, like, an imprint of my body."

Twenge goes on to highlight the data she researched, "Across a range of behaviors —drinking, dating, spending time unsupervised — 18-year-olds now act more like 15-year-olds used to, and 15-year-olds more like 13-year-olds. Childhood now stretches well into high school.

Why are today's teens waiting longer to take on both the responsibilities and the pleasures of adulthood? Shifts in the economy, and parenting, certainly play a role. In an information economy that rewards higher education more than early work history, parents may be inclined to encourage their kids to stay home and study rather than to get a part-time job. Teens, in turn, seem to be content with this homebody arrangement—not because they're so studious, but because their social life is lived on their phone. They don't need to leave home to spend time with their friends."

Of course, the Atlantic article pays special attention to the effects that these habits have on students' mental health: "Teens who spend more time than average on screen activities are more likely to be unhappy, and those who spend more time than average on nonscreen activities are more likely to be happy."

But one related area the article leaves alone is the effect it has on the culture, specifically the culture's view of morality. In her case study, Twenge makes note of teens' prolific use of the application, "Snapchat". What she doesn't mention is the app's <u>reputation as a platform for</u> <u>sexting, as any images that are shared via</u> the app will self-delete after being viewed.

A 2014 article in Time cited a study which delivered surprising results about the prevalence of sexting, "Researchers from Drexel University surveyed college students, asking them if they had ever sent or received 'sexually explicit text messages or images' when they were under age 18. **Fifty-four percent said yes...**"

It's a common enough touchstone among teens for a UK girls fashion store, Missguided, to have recently come under fire for alluding to it in its dressing room décor, which reportedly featured signs reading, "send me nudes."

One wonders how many parents who complained about the indescribably inappropriate signs spent equal energy monitoring the teen culture which inspired them.

Parents, it can't always be someone else's kids. Everyone is someone else to someone else. Kids are doing this right under good parents' noses. If your kid has a mobile device, make sure they're not part of these statistics.

It's time we stop pushing the dangers of these devices to the back of our minds. Maybe they're not sexting. <u>There's still</u> <u>a good chance they're missing out on the</u> joys of real life.

Social media is a high pressure atmosphere. Everyone posts the best parts of their lives, creating the illusion of perfection, literally demanding a covetous response, whether consciously or not. All of this tempts us to join an unmentioned competition, with each post searching for contentment, not in the subject of the post, but in the reaction to it.

That's a tragedy.

An intentional, systematic changing of America began in the early 1900s with one word. From around 1630 until 1900 history was taught from a *providential* view. However, men who would remove God from education and the public square began teaching and rewriting our textbooks from an **economic** view.

Columbus sailed to share the gospel of Jesus in other lands; now we only learn that he was looking for a better trade route. Our forefathers fought England for many political, military, judicial, and moral abuses. Congress is strictly forbidden by the Constitution to make any law prohibiting the free exercise of religion. The federal courts—again—illegally legislate from the bench, showing how America continues to be changed one word, one statue, and one prayer at a time.

# Announcing the retirement of Fay Feldpausch, a treasured board member of American Decency Association

Even as I write this, I'm holding back tears as so many memories come flooding upon me as I think of what Fay Feldpausch means to me and to the American Decency Association Board.

Where to begin? But first this. Fay became a member of our board back in 1992. That's 25 years ago!

Our organization at that time was a state affiliate of the American Family Association. We were the American Family Association of Michigan (1988-1999).

I became aware of Fay as a result of her work with a very active anti-pornography organization operating out of Lansing. Fay's zeal for righteousness, her burden for kids, and her faithfulness were so apparent from the very beginning.

Fay is from a farming community near Lansing and my hometown of Portland. Fay always makes me feel like she is family. Old-fashioned, humble values marked her from the very beginning.

Even after a few years of being on the board Fay would say "I don't know why I'm on this board with all of these knowledgeable, capable people. And, I never say very much!"

I would say "What? Really? <u>Fay, when</u> you speak we all listen. Your words may be few but they are always packed with insight, caring, and wisdom!"

Back around 1998 as the American Family Association of Michigan, we called for a statewide picket of Family Video stores. Picketers gathered in places like Muskegon, Grand Rapids, Gaylord, Ionia, and elsewhere.

Fay, living near Ionia, tried to contact Ionia area pastors to see if she could find some pastors who would join her and urge their members to picket Family Video as Family Video was in the business of renting XXXrated videos. A number of their outlets also

featured so-called "adult" back rooms.

Despite Fay's efforts to rally local pastors and churches, she found **no one** to join with her. **So Fay chose to go out and picket all by herself.** 

While standing out in front of the Ionia Family Video with a picket sign saying something like "Pornography Destroys Children" a reporter/photographer for the Ionia Sentinel spotted Fay all out by her Ionesome and asked if he could take a picture. Fay consented and <u>her picture with</u> <u>picket sign in hand stating "Pornography</u> <u>Destroys Children" appeared on the very</u> <u>front page of the Ionia Sentinel giving</u> <u>warning and alerting the many readers of</u> <u>the Ionia Sentinel!</u>

This picketing all by herself is just one of the reasons why I have often said that Fay Feldpausch exemplifies the heart and soul of American Decency Association!

Fay was not ashamed of the Gospel or of taking a stand for righteousness and was not embarrassed to stand alone!

Here is another vignette from Fay's stand with us for decency, purity, holiness, and children.

Fay "took" to fundraising. Her concern for what she saw going on in regard to the

spread of pornography was so deep that she just couldn't understand why people wouldn't combat it and support the fight against it.

She started by handwriting on a plain white piece of paper about the damage being done regarding pornography - sometimes taking a quote from our newsletter detailing what our ministry was saying and warning about pornography.

She would make copies of her page and then just head out going basically door to door throughout her greater area.

She would report back and say something like (and I'm not exaggerating) I made 640 stops but only 10 gave gifts. But, I will be going out again soon. And, she did many times.

So much more should be said! How we love Fay Feldpausch, and now you can see why, and understand why we will miss her so!

Throughout these ministry efforts, Fay was and is supported by her loving husband, Alick. Together they live out the faith and love that sustains them. May God continue to bless you, Fay and Alick, and keep you in His loving care!
