What will we do with Mercy

In not speaking of any particular candidate, but rather of one party's promise to unleash a tsunami of ultra-progressivism and an unbiblical agenda that would further divide and further push our nation to the brink of destruction, we saw the blatant face of evil rear its ugly head. When you had great deliverances out of sore troubles, and mighty helps in great dangers, you have been able to say, 'I sought the Lord, and He heard

me, and delivered me from all my fears!' Prayer is ALWAYS the preface to blessing."

The question is: What will we do with this mercy shown to us? Will we see it simply as a "reprieve" – to delay punishment or to give temporary relief? Or will we recognize it as a "mercy" – compassionate treatment or a disposition to be kind and forgiving? While both come from the hand of God, if we do our duty, a national reprieve can become extended by God's compassionate mercy upon us. To "do our duty" sounds a little strange in this context; let's see what God has to say about his mercy.

Psalm 103:17 assures us that "the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting," but His mercy is conditional; it's for a specific people. Who are those people? The rest of verse 17 and verse 18 describes who the recipients of such wonderful and everlasting mercy are: "upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children; To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them."

We certainly have much to praise and thank God for, but we must not forget His mighty hand or His mercies or His rightful requirements over our lives. He is holy and expects His people to be holy. He has commanded a way in which we must live; it was given to us not as a fence to keep us from "good"

things, but as a guardrail to keep us from self-destruction. It's a way that brings full joy as opposed to mere temporal happiness from our happenstance.

If we forget the mercy God has shown us and we become apathetic in our responses to Him, then be warned, mercy abused has dire consequences. It will very likely lead to Psalm 106:15. "And he gave them their request; but sent leanness into their **soul.**" God tries the reins of a nation's heart - He tries OUR reins - and gives it their desire. Look at the preceding verses with a sober-mind and humility of heart. Verses 11-12 tell of Israel's complete salvation from the enemy. So, they believed God's words and sang his praise. BUT verses 13-14 tell the story of mercy abused: They soon forgot God's merciful work, they didn't look for His direction, and they lusted after the things of this world instead of chasing after God as their treasure. In response to their actions, God gave them their desire, BUT HE SENT leanness into their soul.

These are not words of warning I wanted to write, but they are truths we need to hear. We prayed for mercy and grace; God spared us from what we can only imagine. What will we do from here? Let us take great care to press on and into the words of Jeremiah in Lamentations 3:40. "Let us search and try our ways, and turn again to the Lord." That is the way to continued mercy.

Personal Note from the President

And again (on another front) how else were we able to pass obscenity legislation and have it signed into law by then Governor John Engler in 1992 without the faithful remnant responding to our need for letters to their state reps and senators - taking action - urging their government leaders to support the passage of the obscenity legislation that together with them - we worked on diligently for upwards of 5 years?

But that was then and now is now. I thought things have become so wicked that such victories seemingly DON'T HAPPEN as people are so desensitized, distracted, and seemingly dumbed down.

Yet, as this election approached, people saw Trump's commitment to lead this nation again. And then we saw all the controversy; hatred; all the suits against him; all the spiritual attacks upon him; and then that moment of treachery - the assassination attempt in Butler, Pa; the fiasco, the utter failure of the Secret Service to protect this hard to define, stalwart man. The Baby Bust By Lisa Van Houten



Nearly 50 years ago, NASA launched Voyager 1, tasked with sending back pictures and data from our solar system and beyond. The intrepid spacecraft continues to make its way through space sending back information from the heavens. However, NASA also sent Voyager off with information about Earth to any supposed extraterrestrial life it may encounter. Called the Golden Record, this message includes sounds and images which depict life on our planet. The Golden Record includes images of a man and woman with a transparent view of a baby developing in the womb. Another photo shows a mother nursing a baby. These pictures communicate an inherent truth which was universally understood 50 years ago - the family is the building block of every society. Yet in nations around the globe, that picture of the family is looking increasingly alien.

In the U.S., the birthrate in every state has plummeted below the replacement level of 2.1 children per woman; however, we aren't alone in this troubling trend. While the U.S. birthrate is only 1.6, the native populations of all European countries have fallen even below that, which means people aren't having enough children to sustain the population. For example, Greece's birthrate is 1.4 and Italy's is a mere 1.3. Birthrates have also collapsed in non-Western countries such as Russia, China, Turkey, Qatar, Japan and South Korea - where the birthrate is 0.72, causing the president to declare it a national emergency.

One small Japanese town has only one child. Pitifully, the village put out child-size dolls, posed on swings and bikes, to try to foster the feeling of family. Twice as many Japanese are dying as are being born. That is unsustainable for any country. Falling birthrates will speed the decline of national cultures. In a number of decades, there could be few native Italians, for example. However, the birthrate for Muslim immi-

grants who have flooded Europe is 2.54; you can do the math.

The future consequences will be devasting both economically and socially. Fewer babies mean fewer workers. There will be a growing healthcare crisis, with not enough workers to care for the aging population, who have no children and grandchildren to help fill that need. In a heartbreaking scenario, Japan is trying to develop robot technology to care for the aged in nursing homes. Social Security, which once had four or five workers paying into the system per one retiree, now has dropped to nearly two to one. Equally devastating is the emotional and social harm caused when a society stops having babies. It's a fundamental fact that children make people happy, as studies prove that those with children are happier than their childless counterparts. The New York Times recently published an article entitled: "The Unspoken Grief of Never Becoming a Grandparent," showing the anguish of missing out on the joy of grandchildren.

So, what has led to this plummeting birthrate? A recent Pew Research survey found that 47% of Americans without children, aged 18-49, do not plan to ever have children. Of those, only 13% cited infertility or other medical concerns as a factor. It's heartbreaking for those who long for children, but circumstances have prevented it. However, the top reason given by those choosing not to have children was "they just don't want to." Pew writes: "Not having kids has made it easier for them to afford the things they want..." TikTok videos show couples extoling their DINK (dual income, no kids) lifestyle - boasting of their lavish vacations and "pet children." Selfindulgence over self-sacrifice is the theme, and children require sacrifice. They also bring joy – and fill a void that no vacation or pet can ever fill.

Leftist ideology is also a contributing factor, as at least 32% of Democrats list climate change as a contributing factor in choosing not to have children. Climate activists claim that children are bad for the environment, such as Biden's Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Director Tracy Stone-Manning who called children an "environmental haz-


ard." Yet research shows that as the population has increased throughout history, by God's provision, food production has also increased. As Elon Musk stated in 2022, "Population collapse due to low birth rates is a much bigger risk to civilization than global warming," adding: "America is trending towards extinction."

Our education system has also steeped young adults in cultural Marxism, which is rooted in the abolition of the nuclear family. Then there's the sexual revolution, which separated sex from marriage and reproduction. Feminist ideology often depicts motherhood as demeaning, where children are seen as an obstacle to personal autonomy. Yet, this quest for personal autonomy is fool's gold, as shown by the current epidemic rates of loneliness and depression. And the proverbial elephant in the room in any discussion of falling birthrates is the skyrocketing abortion rates in the last fifty years. Since 1973, there have been more than 63 million babies killed in their mother's womb. Imagine the positive impact those individuals would have had over the decades if they had been allowed to live. Just as fewer babies cause negative consequences to a nation, more babies bring positive impacts. More people mean more goods and services are needed, which means more jobs, which means a solvent Social Security – and that's just a few of the economic benefits. There's a reason we say babies are a blessing.

Yet the rejection of the Christian worldview, which teaches that children are a gift from God, is at the heart of the declining birthrate. As theologian Albert Mohler stated in his Daily Briefing, "a worldview against having babies is the direct contradiction of and disobedience of the first command God gave to human beings, which is to be fruitful and to multiply and to fill the earth."

A culture that rejects God and His design, which worships self and pleasure, is on a calamitous path. The Omnipotent God, Creator of the universe, chooses to reveal Himself as Father and those who are His own, He calls His children. That alone should show the immense value of family.

Back With a Vengeance By Chris Johnson



When Hollywood A-lister Zach Levi voiced his support of Donald Trump's reelection in October, he said it wasn't just the former president he was voting for: "This team — this 'Avengers...' whatever you want to call it — they're going to get in there and actually do what Donald Trump said he was going to do the first time, which is drain the swamp."

And, having been rejected by the leadership of his family's historic party loyalty, he's unbeholden to play nice with the radical left in his new position of head of the Department of Health and Human Services.

Tulsi Gabbard - veteran, former Democrat

While Trump gets to work on "MAGA," Christians in the administration and on the outside, by God's Grace, must work on MACA, "Make America Christian Again."



The Sleeper Issue that Woke a Giant

In the recent presidential election, Democrats, pundits, and even many Republicans were stunned to learn that, among swing voters, the number one reason they broke for Donald Trump wasn't because of immigration or the economy, but the transgender agenda pushed by Kamala Harris and her party.

Trump has said, if he had discussed transgender ideology during the 2016 campaign, no one would have known what he was talking about. That's how fast this cultural tsunami has been forced down our throats by the leftists in control of society's levers of power. Yet the American people aren't buying this indoctrination which denies biology and common sense. Trump got an inkling of this undercurrent of opposition from the reaction he received during a 2023 speech where he vowed to cut federal funding for schools pushing transgender ideology. He marveled, "Look at the hand you get for that! Bigger than, 'We're going to be energy independent!""

Polling has backed that up: both Republicans (86%) and Democrats (58%) oppose allowing minors to attempt to "change" their gender. Overall, 72% of Americans oppose mutilating transgender surgeries and puberty blockers for children. On what other issue do nearly three-quarters of Americans agree? In addition, only 13% think boys should be allowed in girls' sports, and only 19% think transgender propaganda should be taught in schools.

The Trump team, realizing the power of this concern, made it a major focus of their campaign, with ads such as: "Kamala is for they/them. President Trump is for you." The New York Times reported that these were Trump's most viewed and most effective ads, acknowledging that one specific ad, exposing Kamala Harris's radical transgender positions, "shifted the race 2.7 per-

centage points in Mr. Trump's favor after viewers watched it." And as Democrats incessantly beat the pro-abortion drum in an effort to reach suburban women, the Trump ads on the transgender issue were proven to be highly effective in winning moderate suburban women, as well as black and Latino men. Polling showed that the percentage of voters who oppose child sex changes increased by 10 points since August. Opposition to this radical ideology became the sleeper issue of the 2024 election.

Other Republicans – some of whom can be notoriously slow to take principled stands on what are considered cultural issues, but are actually a matter of what is morally right or wrong - stuck their finger in the wind and realized this was a winning issue. Down ballot candidates also successfully campaigned on the facts that children are irreversibly harmed by transgender "treatments;" parents, not bureaucrats, should decide what children are taught regarding sexuality; and that men don't belong in women's bathrooms or sports.

This election made clear that the majority of voters reject woke ideology. However, voters in the blue state of Delaware didn't seem to get the message, as they elected Tim McBride, who cosplays at being a woman and now goes by the name Sarah McBride, as the first "transgender" congressman to the House of Representatives. This could potentially cause actual female Congresswomen to be forced to share a restroom with a biological man, leading Republican Rep. Nancy Mace to introduce a House resolution requiring legislators and staffers to use bathrooms that align with their biological sex, stating that "allowing biological males into single-sex facilities, such as restrooms, locker rooms, and changing rooms designed for women, jeopardizes the safety and dignity of Members, officers, and employees of the House who are female." As Mace told a reporter: "I'm a rape survivor. I have PTSD from the abuse I've suffered at the hands of a man, and I know how vulnerable women and girls are in private spaces." Mace also introduced a bill which would ban men from using women's facilities on all federal property.

Of course, Mace was vilified by Democrats

who haven't learned from the thrashing the American people just gave them, precisely because of this woke garbage. Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez (D-NY) claimed Mace's resolution was "not just bigotry" but "plain bullying." So, deviant men in makeup want to force women to participate in their delusion and we're the bullies? Democrat women, who just a few short years ago cried #MeToo in defense of female victims of sexual harassment and assault, are now not only betraying their own gender to defend perverted men, but would also force those same victims of assault to share intimate facilities with men.

Republicans, who just won a resounding victory partly due to this issue, should be emboldened to take strong and principled stands wherever the trans agenda rears its ugly head. However, when Speaker of the House Mike Johnson [R] was asked by a reporter - "Is freshman-elect Sarah McBride a man or a woman?" - Johnson deflected, stating he wasn't going to "engage in silly debates about this." What is "silly" about the Biblical truth and biological fact that one's gender is immutable? As a conservative and a Christian who's been vocal about his faith in the past, this should not have been a hard question for him to answer.

Every Christian from apostle Peter to yours truly has cowardly not taken opportunities to speak the truth. Thankfully, Mike Johnson, whether resulting from the mocking he received or his own conscience, soon came out and stated: "...let me be unequivocally clear. A man is a man and a woman is a woman. And a man cannot become a woman." He also later announced: "All single-sex facilities in the Capitol and House Office Buildings — such as restrooms, changing rooms, and locker rooms—are reserved for individuals of that biological sex. ... Women deserve women's only spaces."

Woke, transgender ideology isn't about privacy or politics. It's not even ultimately about gender; **it's about Truth**. It's about trying to force people to believe a lie and deny what God has written on every human heart since "male and female He created them." Thankfully, the American people are waking up and rejecting this lie.

What is a Doctor? By Steve Huston



What is a Doctor? is the title of Dr. Simone Gold's new and outstanding documentary; she asks this important question about her profession as "doctors are not acting ethically or honorably" regarding various issues. Dr. Gold gained recognition during COVID as she stood boldly as a truth teller, particularly regarding masks, ivermectin, hydroxychloroquine, and standards of care. Now, with this new documentary, she addresses the treatment – MIStreatment – of gender dysphoric youth ("transgenderism").

As I sat down to write this article, Frank Gaffney of "Securing America" had just interviewed Dr. Gold regarding this film, giving it a glowing recommendation. He notes that this particular documentary comes at a most vital time: just before the Supreme Court hears oral arguments about a Tennessee law that "protects children in that state from the physical mutilation and psychological trauma associated with so called 'gender affirming care." Frank continues: "To its eternal shame, the Biden administration has sided with parents who support such child abuse. Providentially, however, one of America's most brilliant and courageous Frontline Doctors, Simone Gold, has just released a powerful documentary called 'What is a Doctor?' It searingly exposes the truth about the medical practitioners, hospitals, and pharmaceutical industry that are profiting massively off of the lifetimes of health complications and suffering, to which they are condemning purported "trans" kids who are incapable of providing informed consent."

"I have seen it and I urge every American to do the same. Most especially, I pray that every member of the Supreme Court will take the time to view 'What is a Doctor?,' ideally before they hear the case next month, and for sure before they rule on it thereafter. If they do, my best bet is they will decide nine to zero to protect Tennessee's and America's children from this horrific form of medical malpractice and torture."

Have you noticed the explosion of transgenderism, particularly among school-aged children in the last several years? Have you wondered why all of a sudden there's a politicized medical agenda surrounding this psychological disorder and how the medical community could willingly play a role in such insanity? Dr. Gold and several other doctors speak to this, abhorred by what is taking place and standing boldly against it, regardless the personal cost.

Gender Identity Disorder (renamed "gender dysphoria") was almost exclusively an issue with middle-age to older men who had been cross-dressing for years; it's always been known as a psychological condition. Now we see adolescent girls to young adult women who have had no issues, no discomfort with their biological sex while they were growing up, but now having been bombarded with social media messaging, other online influences, and suggestions from guidance counselors and doctors are convinced and driven to unbelievable harm through medical interventions (including mutilations) which leave them physically, psychologically, and socially scarred, often for life. This is "rapid onset gender dysphoria" and should be differentiated from the Gender Identity Disorder addressed earlier.

These children and teens are unable to give "informed consent" because they cannot understand the true meaning of what they are giving up when allowing these doctors to perform horrendous atrocities to their bodies. Even in looking at hormone blockers or cross-hormone therapy, do we know what role our God-given hormones play during our psychological and mental development during our prepubescent and teen years? We must never forget that "we are fearfully and wonderfully made."

Dr. Gold, in her interview with Frank Gaffney, states that physicians ought to be a beacon of reality instead of simply complying with the fantasy of these teens/young adults. "It is unreal, it is false to say to a patient in front of you, 'Yes, young lady, you can be-

come a male.' It is factually impossible. Even if you were to go on all of the crosssex hormones and puberty blockers, and manipulate your body in a cosmetic way to appear more masculine, every cell in your body, young lady, would still be XX chromosome. Every brain cell, every heart cell, every nerve cell, every lung cell, it will still be XX. All the testosterone in the world will still hit XX cells in your brain. That is the role that physicians need to be telling the patients. We must treat them with respect and kindness and love and compassion. Having gender dysphoria is an extremely painful condition, however the answer is not to medically mutilate your healthy body. If you start going down that road, not only will you not accomplish what you're hoping to accomplish...you are opening yourself up to terrible medical consequences." She goes on to list off what some of these consequences are, both in this interview and in the documentary.

While not part of the film, we need to remember that man was created in the image of God and "male and female created he them." Then we must recognize that an attack on the image of God (abortion, physiological and psychological "supports" of transgenderism, etc.) is an attack on God. I am grateful for bold truth tellers in the medical community like Dr. Gold and those who joined her in this documentary, but let us also be bold in speaking the truth both medically and spiritually.

Advent: From Loss to Victory By Chris Johnson



Ever since reading an article by Molly Hemmingway extolling the wonder of the Advent season nearly a decade ago, December 1st through the 25th has been one of my favorite times of the year. I think for about every year since then, I've written as much in our December newsletter.

But December 1, 2023, the first day of the Advent season last year, was the worst day of my life, and it will forever change the way I experience the Advent season.

I woke in the early hours of the morning to sounds of distress from my wife, and the nightmare of every pregnant couple became our experience as our tiny little son was stillborn to my wife in her 18th week of pregnancy.

That evening, we buried our son in a little home-made casket quickly assembled by my skilled brother-in-law in our backyard.

We spent the next few weeks in a season of only slightly controlled chaos leaning on family, feeding on the outpouring of encouragement and love both from those close to us and from those from whom we never would have expected it, trying to help each other and our older children to process the loss of what we were all so excited for.

"He got to go straight to live with Jesus," we told them. He didn't have to go through the hard stuff in life that we all will.

It was that truth, and the truth of Romans 8:28, that "...for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose," that echoed in my head in the following weeks and months.

Someday, God will use our experience to encourage someone else who's struggling to trust in His goodness in a difficult moment of their life. Really, that's the reason I'm writing this now, perhaps now is that

time for someone reading this.

Within just a few weeks of the passing of our little guy, whom we posthumously named Kuyper, we were celebrating our family Christmas, and rather than turn to Luke to read the Christmas story, or to the Old Testament to read the prophecies of Christ's coming as we've done in the past, this time we turned to 1 Corinthians 15:25-26 and read," For he must reign until He has put all His enemies under His feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death."

The real reason for Christmas can be easily lost in sentimentalism: Hallmark movies, Coca-Cola Santas, Currier and Ives prints, Jingle Bells, and the Grinch.

When Christ *is* celebrated, its for his helpless state as an infant. To read most summations of the Christmas story is to read of a little baby boy born in poverty to a single mother who went on to save the world. And when boiled down to those elements, the Christmas story can resound with anyone in our time, Christian or not.

But that story, without the context of the rest of the Bible, doesn't explain why Christmas is so important to Christians. We celebrate Christmas because Jesus came here for a reason, and that reason was made painfully clear to me on December 1, 2023.

Most Christmas carols don't cover it, but one singer who is the front man for an Alternative Rock band, Dustin Kensrue, sang this on his Christmas album:

"This is war like you ain't seen.
This winter's long, it's cold and mean.
With hangdog hearts we stood condemned,
But the tide turns now at Bethlehem.

This is war and born tonight,
The Word as flesh, the Lord of Light,
The Son of God, the low-born king;
Who demons fear, of whom angels sing.

This is war on sin and death; The dark will take its final breath. It shakes the earth, confounds all plans; The mystery of God as man."

If you are missing someone this Christmas season, and maybe it's even preventing you from celebrating the holiday, remember this: our greatest enemy which separates us from our loved ones is Jesus' enemy too, and He will not rest until He has crushed that enemy.

We celebrate Christmas because Christ came to conquer sin and death. That's the reason for the season.

The story of my family's loss of Kuyper isn't over. Psalm 30:5 says, "Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning," and on October 1st, 2024, Jaelle Joy was born to our family.

While she can't fill the hole that Kuyper left in our lives, she certainly does bring comfort and joy.

Our Advents from here on out will begin with the memory of the loss of our baby boy, and end in the celebration of the birth of Baby Jesus, Whose birth leads us to ask with the Apostle Paul, "O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?"

"But let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious."

~ 1 Peter 3:4

God does not prize the rich things in the world - gold, silver, land, possessions and crowns. What are these to God? He does not regard the nations of the world with all their pomp and glory, but a meek and quiet spirit is high in God's esteem. Most of the words listed as fruit of the spirit (Gal. 5:22-23) are synonyms of meekness. The Lord looks upon the meek as the most brave and excellent spirits. He that is slow to wrath is better than the mighty (Prov. 16: 32). If a man is seeking a wife, the first important quality is a meek spirit; without that, let her have whatever else she will, she is often rejected. If you are traveling, wouldn't you rather stay in an inn where the host and servants are of a quiet spirit? Whatever wrongs a meek man has in this world, he yields his cause to God, and keeps his heart quiet, and this interests God in his cause.
